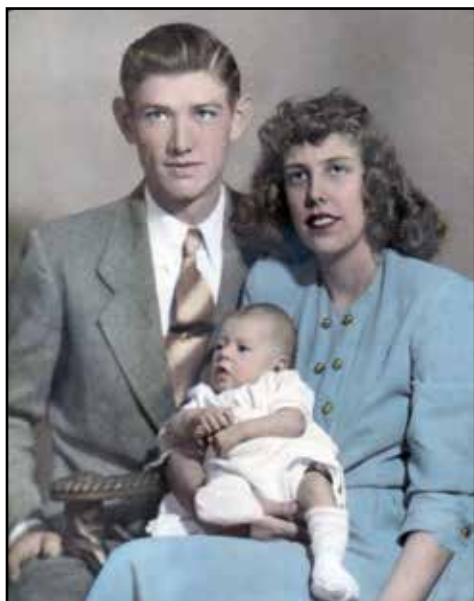

He is preceded in death by his parents; daughter, Julie Ann Terry; and cousin, Donnie Terry.

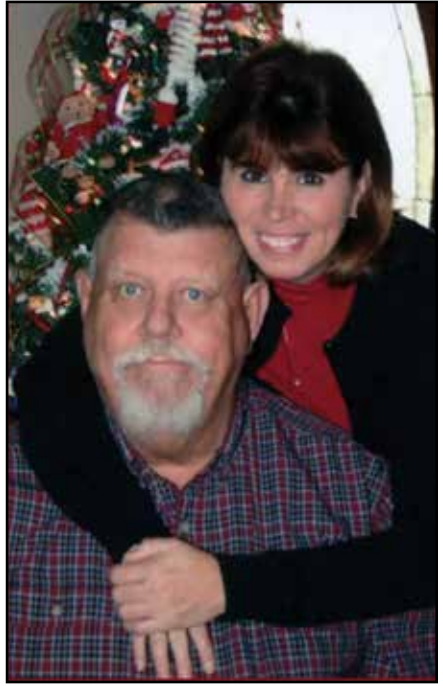
