Richard Glen Worley, 81 of Silsbee, died Tuesday, December 13, 2022. He was born on September 17, 1941, in Silsbee, to Edna Joy Worley and Ladson Ervin “Red” Worley.

Richard graduated from Silsbee High School in 1959 and attended Lamar University. He served on the Silsbee ISD Board of Trustees for nearly twenty years and retired from Eastex Pulp and Paper after almost four decades. He later worked for the Hardin County Emergency Management-Floodplain Office and served on the Hardin County Appraisal Board.

Richard was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, serving in numerous capacities including bishop. He had a genuine love for people and his life was intertwined with service to others as well as his family. He was a kind, humble man who impacted the lives of many. After retirement, he enjoyed a special camaraderie with his buddies from McDonald’s, Brookshire Brothers, and the Donut Palace.
