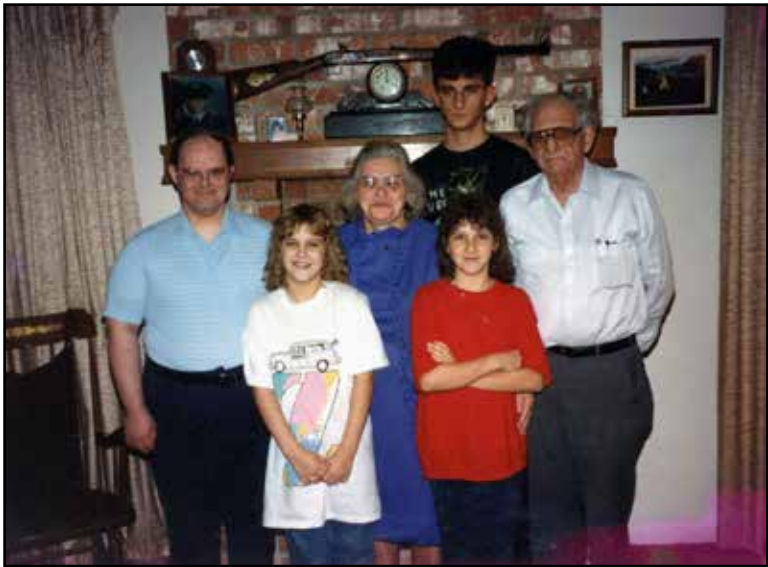

He is preceded in death by his parents and his brother, Robert Ashelman.





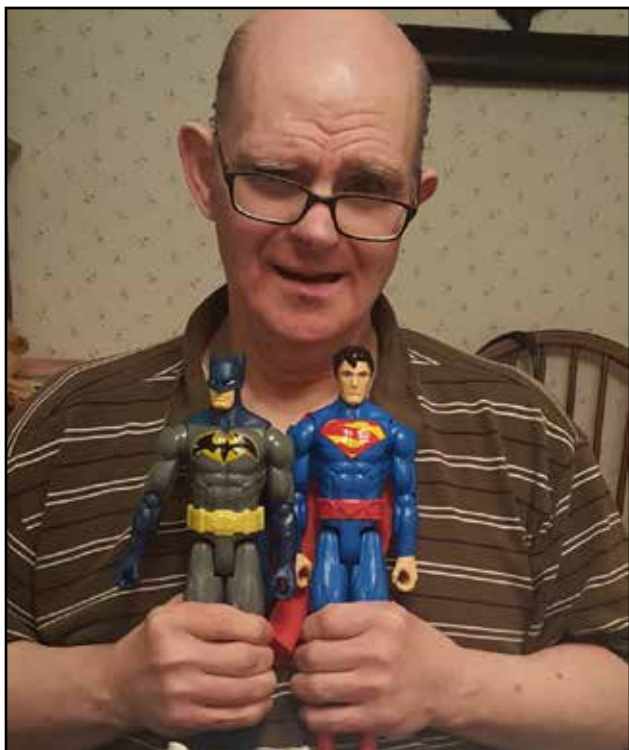


















PAUL ASHELMAN
