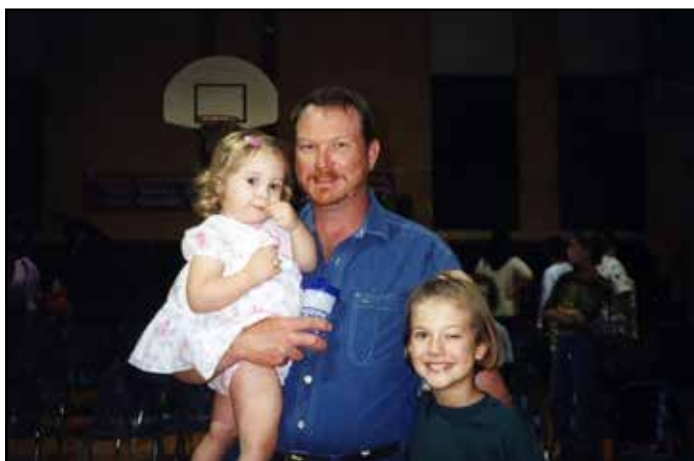
Mike is preceded in death by his parents, Wayne and Joan Valentine.
