and their beautiful marriage set the example for what true love should be. Theirs will forever be the love that their children and grandchildren aspire to emulate.

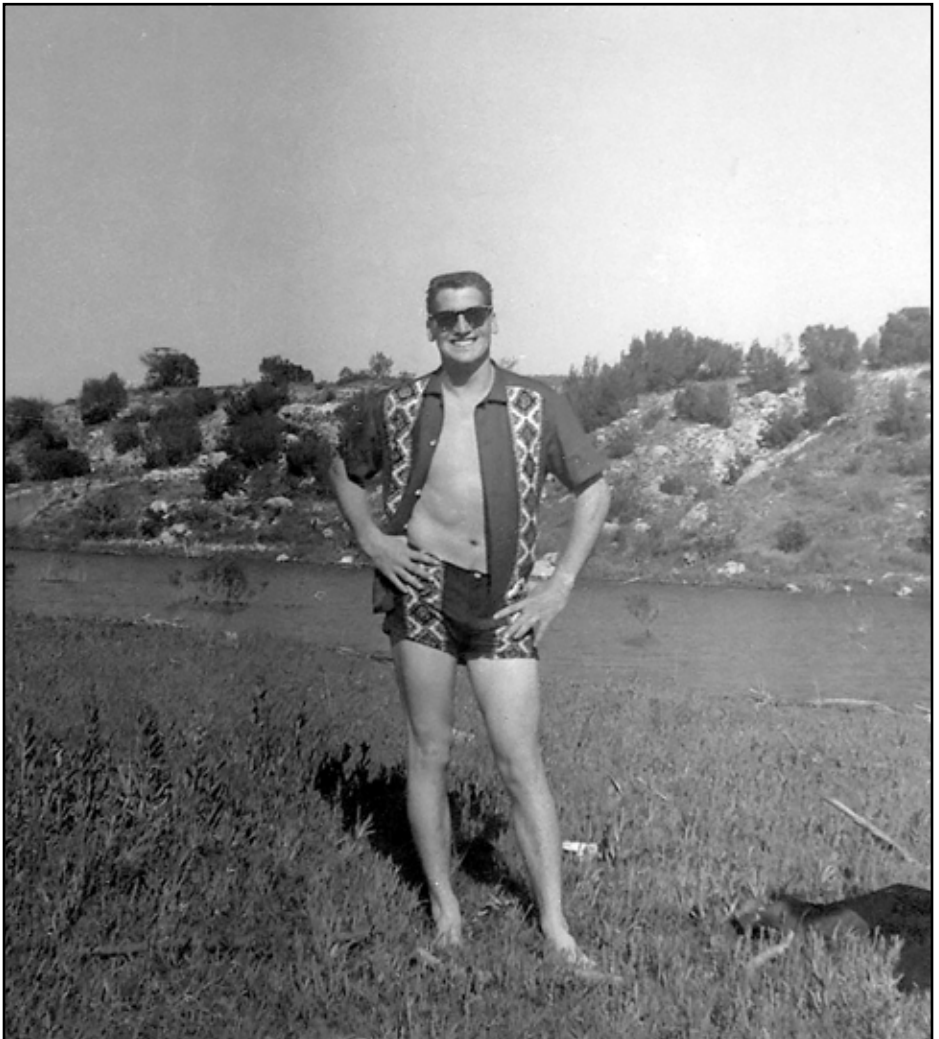
