Juanita Shirley Behymer Macon, 88, of Nederland, died March 12, 2023. Alice and O.C. Behymer gave birth to Juanita on September 12, 1934, in Baytown, Texas. In 1952, she graduated from Robert E. Lee High School in Baytown. After completing high school, Juanita graduated from Southwest Texas University receiving a teaching degree.

June 15, 1957, she married Floyd C. Macon, her husband of sixty-five years. They moved to Nederland in 1960. Juanita worked as a teacher in Port Arthur. After having her sons, Mitchell and Greg, she left teaching to stay at home with her sons. Juanita enjoyed crafting and for a brief time, she co-owned a craft shop with her best friend.

Juanita was a loyal member of First United Methodist Church in Nederland. She was active in many areas of the church, such as the meals on wheels program and the United Methodist Women Group. She listened enthusiastically while they told her about their school activities. Some grandchildren would even perform for her. She was very proud of them. Juanita never missed any of their events and did everything she could to attend any sports game or recital. Juanita was loved by all and will be greatly missed.

The family would like to extend their sincerest gratitude to all the caregivers that cared for her during her later years.

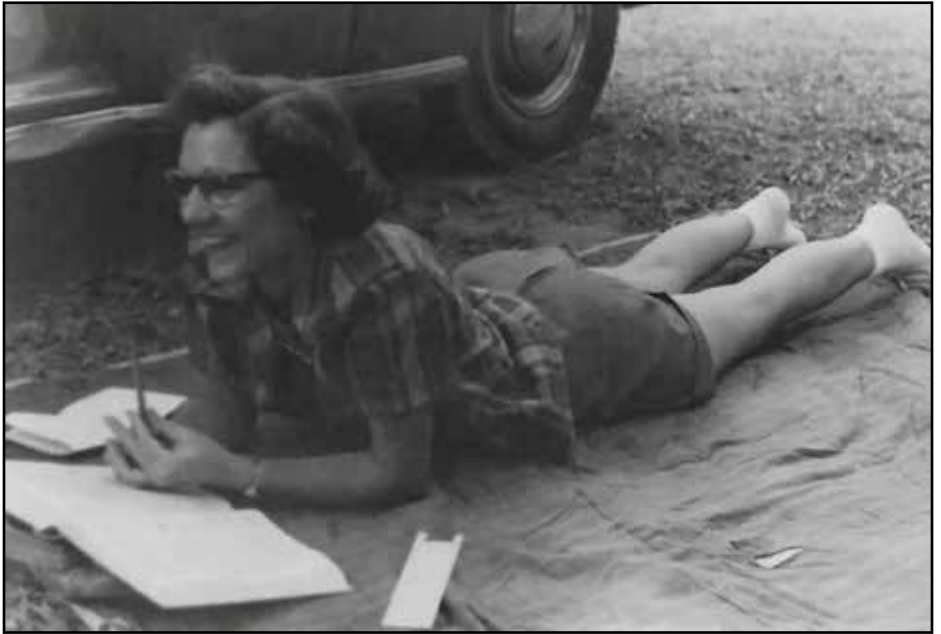
