He is preceded in death by his parents; and sister, Patricia Osburn.









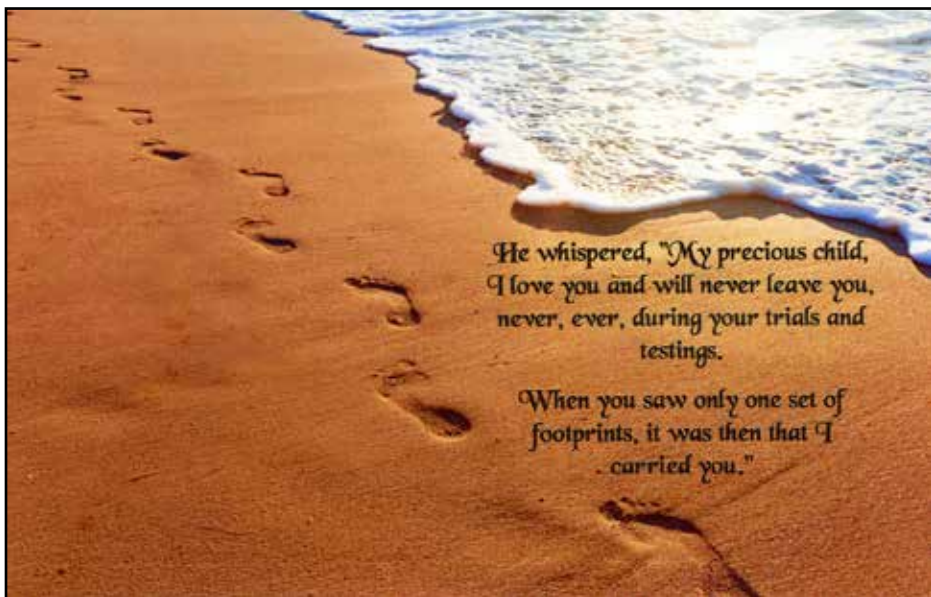












## The Lord's Prayer
