***Marciano Antonio Guerrero, Sr.***, 82, of Lumberton, died Friday, April 21, 2023. He was born on August 26, 1940, in Matamoros, Mexico.

Marciano moved to Galveston, Texas when he was 16 years old with his father, Daddy ‘O Sanchez, and the rest of his family. Marciano became an experienced paint and body repairman. His first job was at a paint and body shop in Orange, Texas. He then later moved to

Beaumont, Texas and started his own paint and body shop called, “Star Paint and Body Shop.”

In 1965, he married Mary Ellen, his wife of fifty-seven years, and together they had three children. In 1987, they founded Elena’s Mexican Restaurant on College Street, where it still stands today.

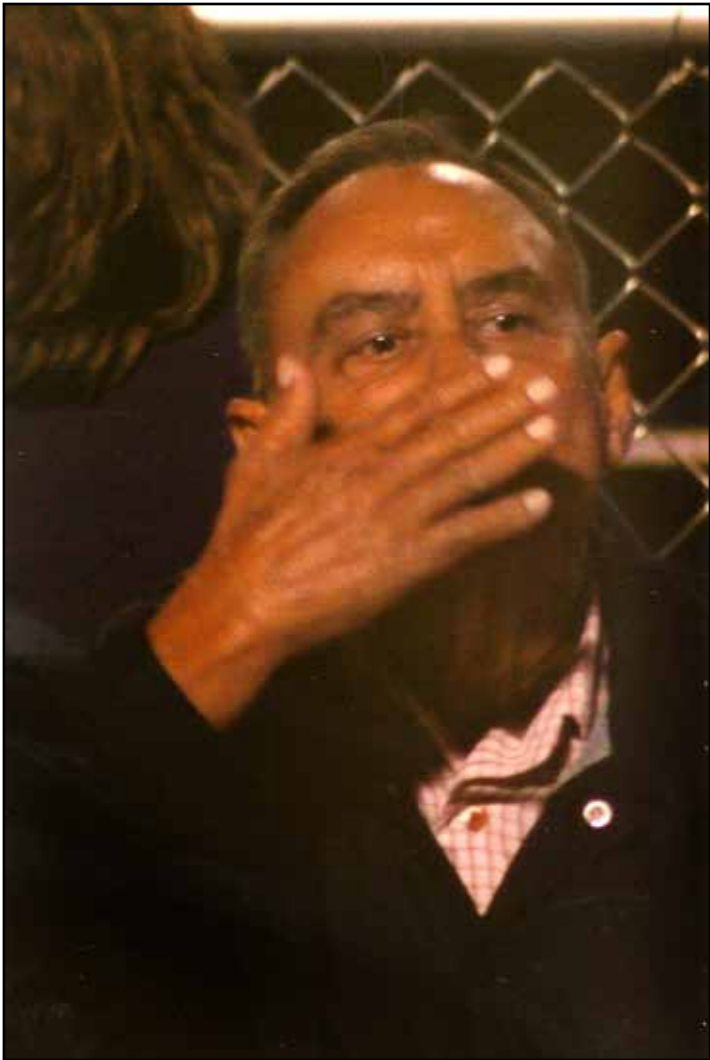
