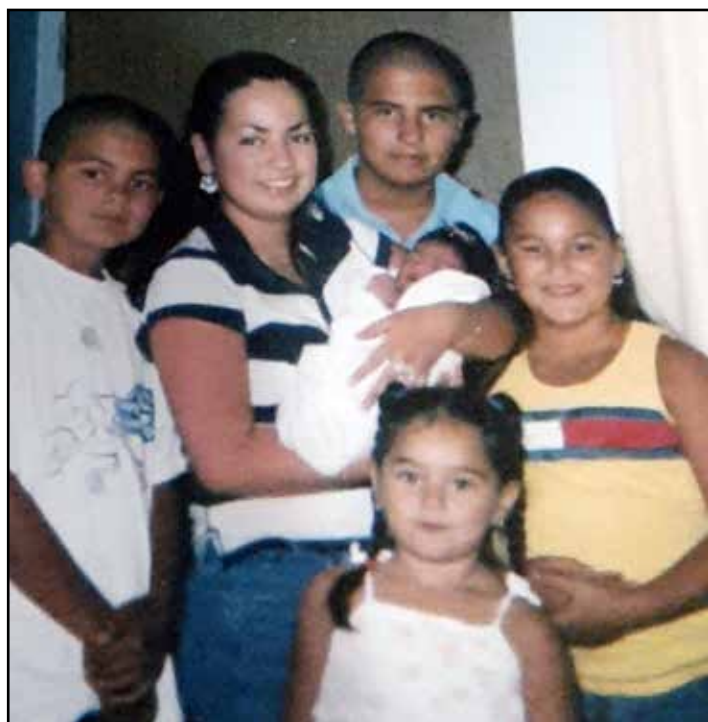

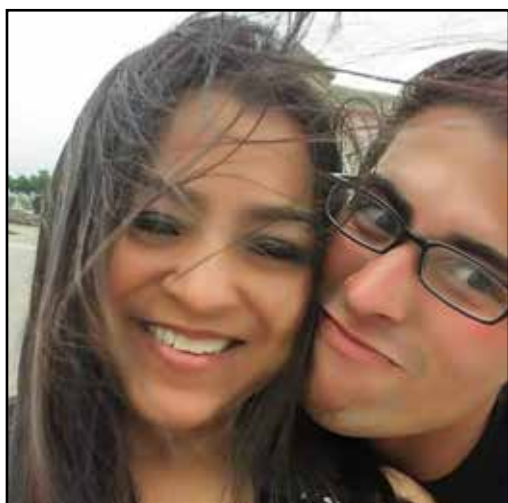
Carlos enjoyed music and dancing. He was very artistic and enjoyed creating photo albums and art. He will forever remain a loving son, brother, and uncle.

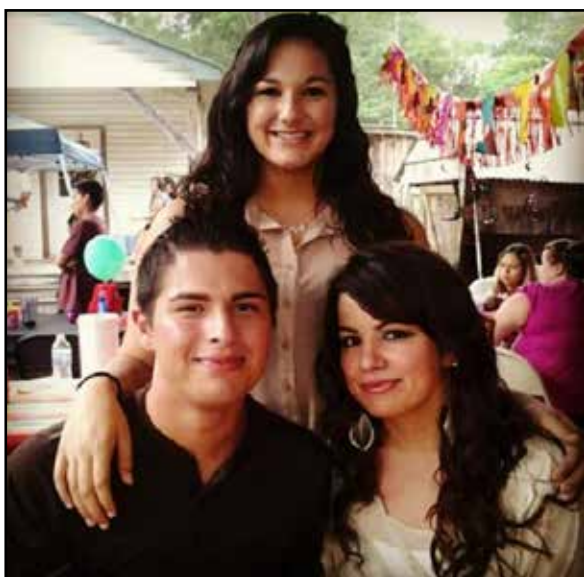
