

John Andrew Raney, Jr., 90, of Beaumont, died Saturday, April 29, 2023, at Buckner Calder Woods, Beaumont. He was born February 4, 1933, in Beaumont, to Viola Mae Creamer Raney and John Andrew Raney, Sr.

John was the owner of Raney Plumbing and Heating and was a vice president for twenty-five years of Hancock Whitney Bank (formerly Mid-South
