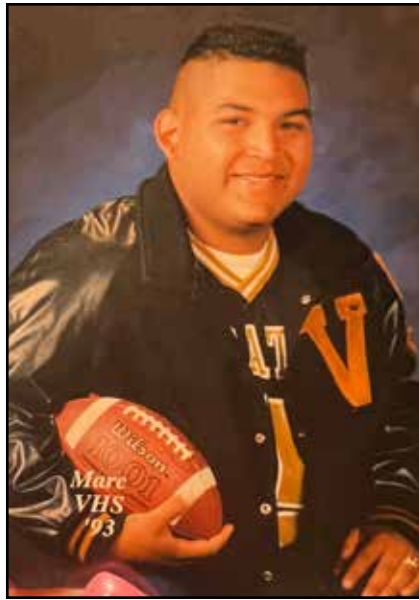

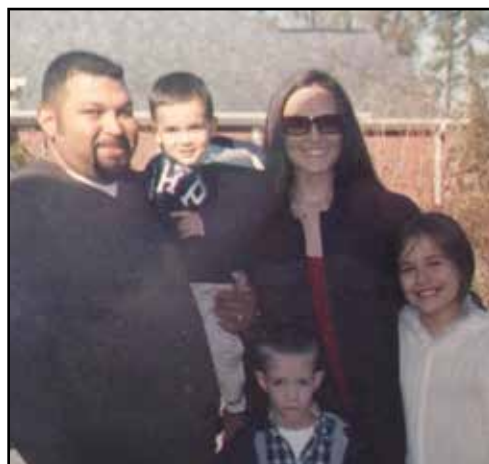












FOOTPRINTS
