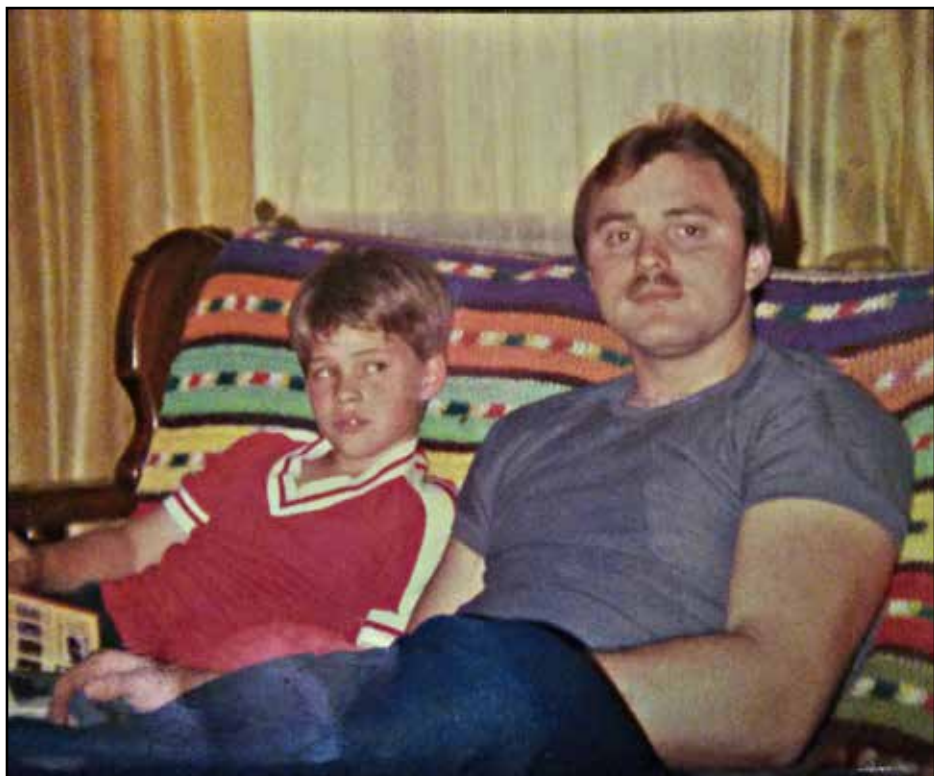

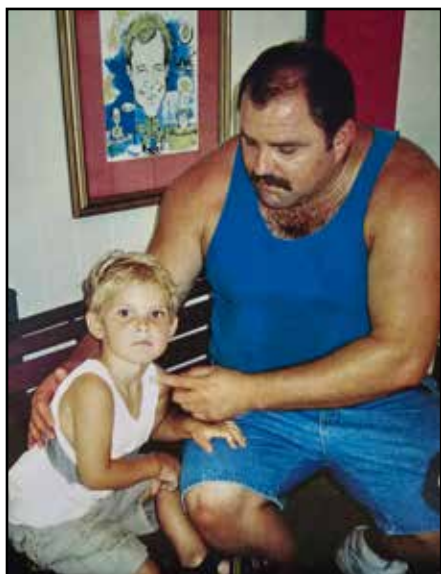
He is preceded in death by his parents; son, Jeremiah Spencer; sister, Carroll Jean; and brother, Patrick Snyder.

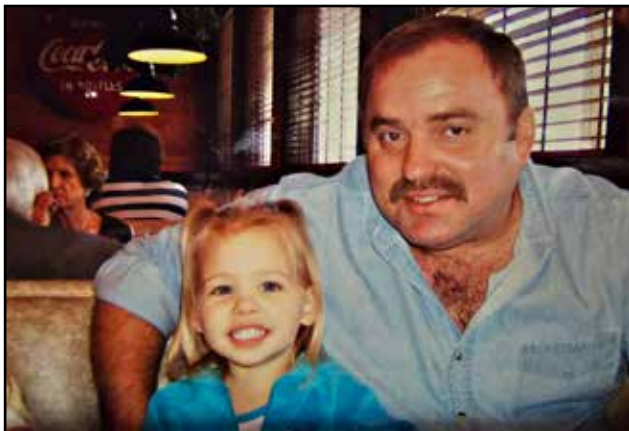
