Mary Ann passed away Monday, June 19, 2023. She was born in Beaumont, Texas on August 20, 1926. Her parents were John M. Frank and Vada Bellard Frank.

She attended South Park Elementary where she met her husband to be, Reggie Iles in the third grade. She was a member of the South Park Simfonnettes, Glee Club, Dramatic Club, the
