Misti touched so many lives during her short time on this earth and was a true blessing to everyone who knew her.

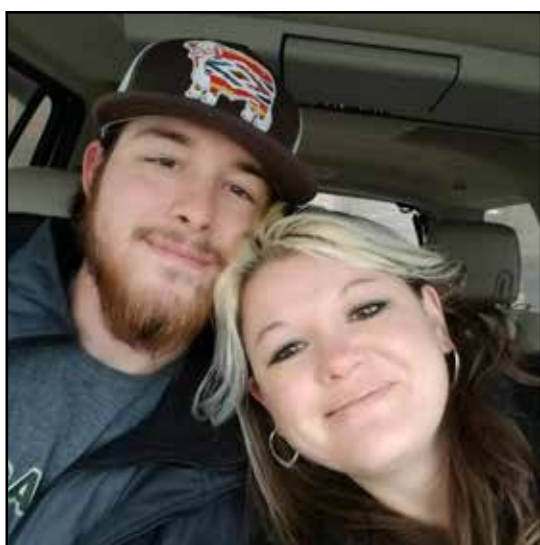

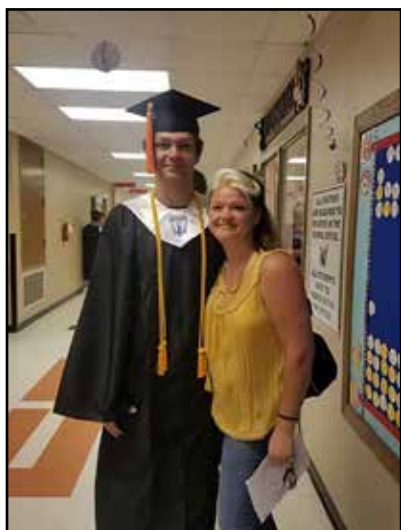



