Lexie had a bright and energetic personality. She touched many lives with her story.

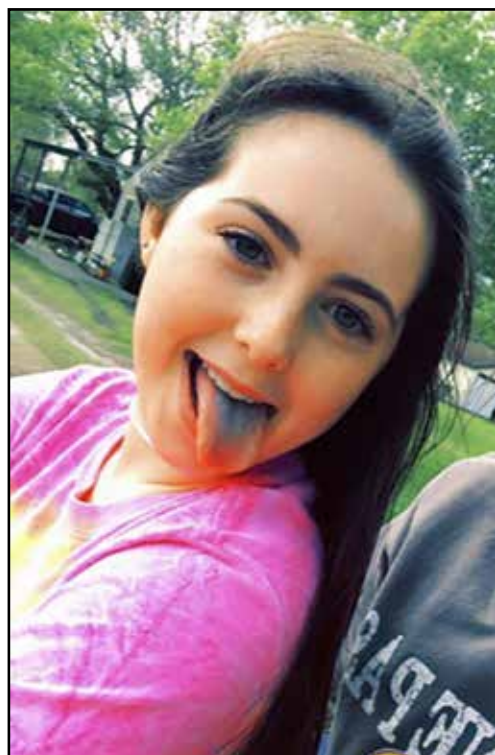
To know her was to love her. She may be gone but she’s never forgotten.

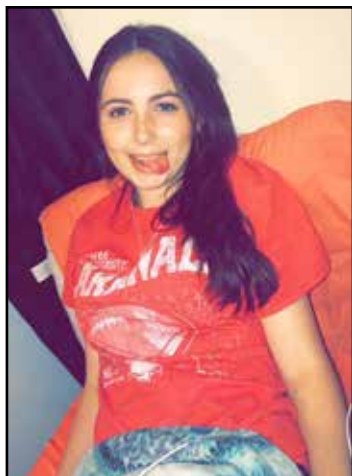
