

Dillon was born and raised in Beaumont, Texas. He started his school journey at Wesley Pre-School with his brother, Colton, they were both very popular as everyone loves a pair of twins. He is preceded in death by his mother, Rebecca, in May of 2022, and grandmother, Roberta, in September of 2021.







