Gregory Kobrin was born on September 2, 1933, to Mary and Harry Kobrin. Greg's father, Harry, immigrated to the United States from Kiev, Ukraine as a teenager. Greg was raised in Waterbury, Connecticut, and only spoke Russian until he began school at 5 years of age. He graduated from the University of Connecticut in 1955 with a degree in Chemistry. Greg then began a 40 plus year career as a metallurgist at DuPont.

Greg met Dorothy Dyer, the love of his life in Charleston, West Virginia, at Christ Methodist Church. They were both members of the Charleston Light Opera Guild. The two were later married on June 29, 1957.

Greg and Dot moved to Beaumont in 1965. They were active members of Trinity United Methodist Church choir and youth fellowship. In later years, Greg and Dot were active members of Cathedral in the Pines Christian Center and then Christian Fellowship. Greg served faithfully on the board of elders at both churches. Greg's career afforded him the opportunity to travel extensively in the US and abroad. He was blessed to have Dot accompany him on many of his trips.

He is preceded in death by his beloved wife, Dorothy; parents, Mary and Harry Kobrin; and brother Ted Kobrin.
