He is preceded in death by his brother-in-law, Christopher Dominguez.

















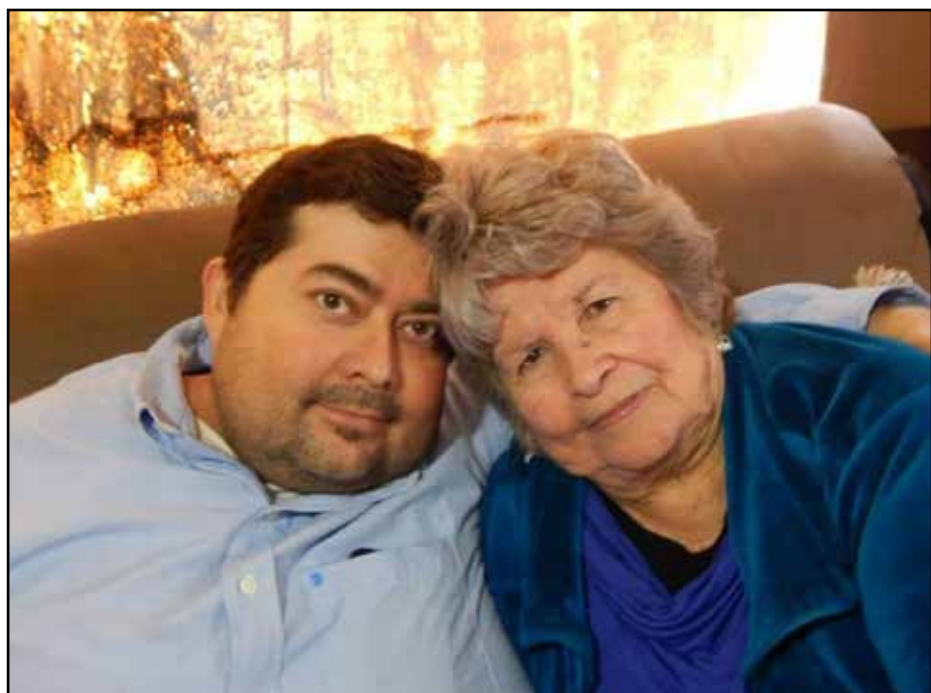
