

# **Marshall David Day**

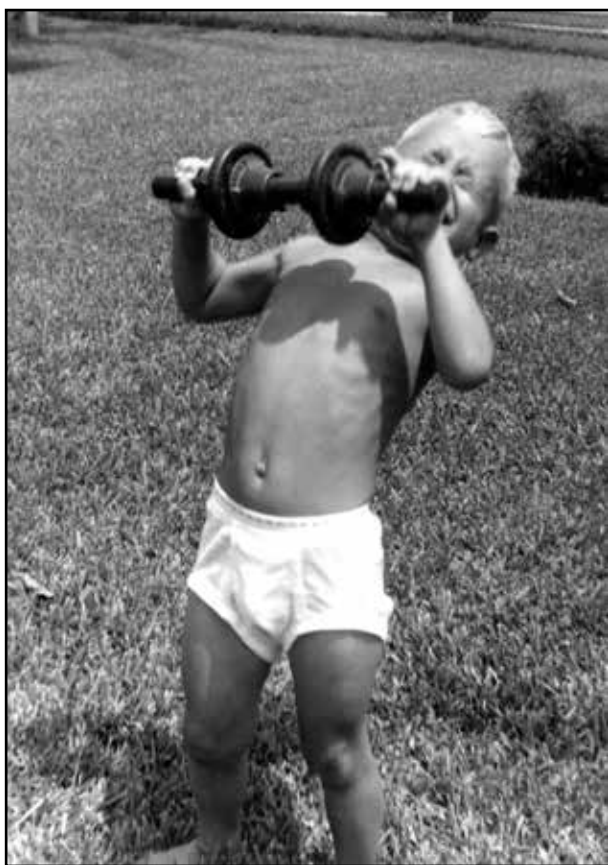

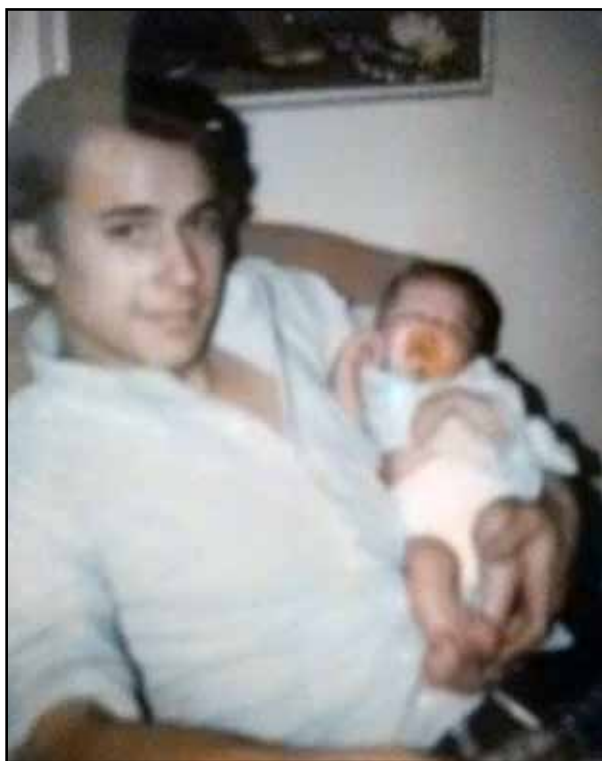

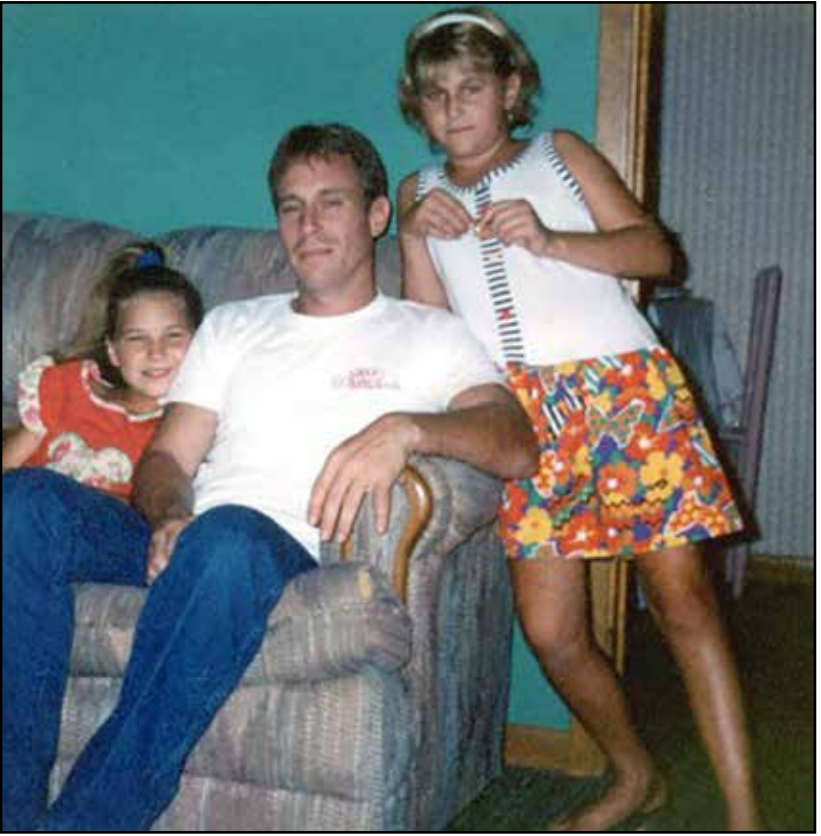
