She is preceded in death by her sister, Dolores Martinez.







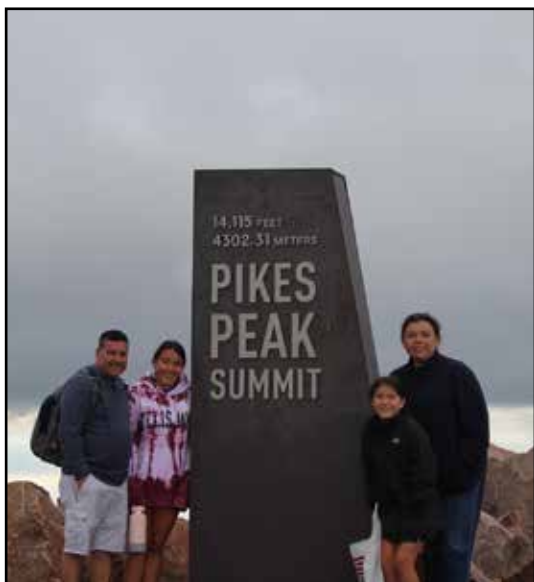
