He is preceded in death by his parents, sister, Gail Marie Wall, and nephew, Patrick Dillon, Jr.



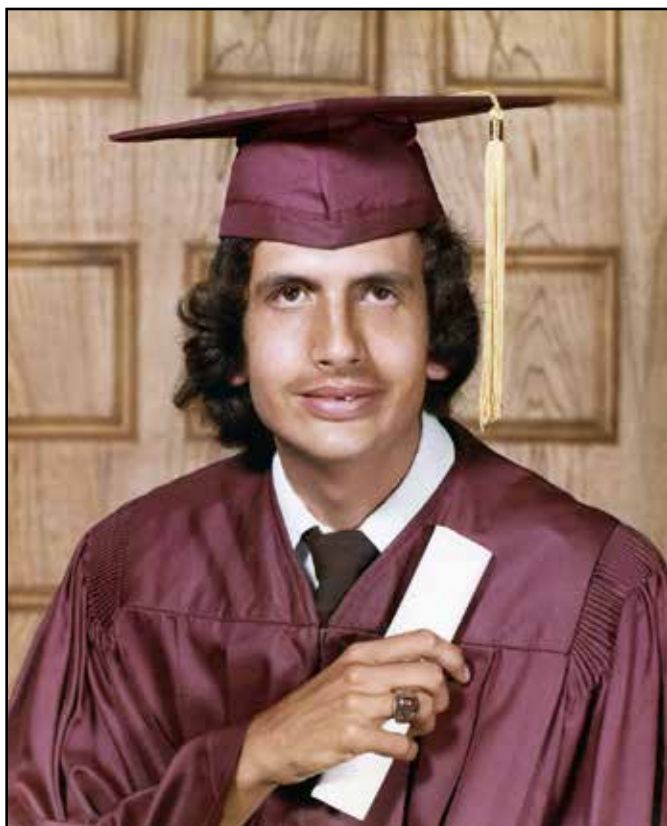
