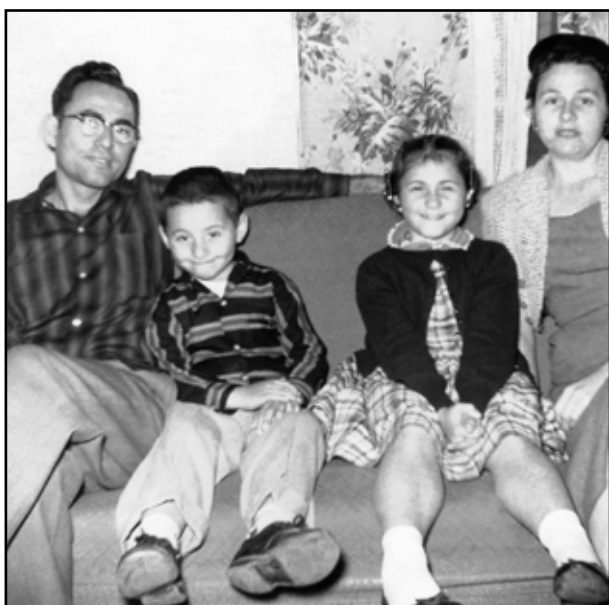
Recessional *"How Great Thou Art"*
