In addition to her role as a wife and mother, Tot was a member of the First Pentecostal Church in Silsbee.

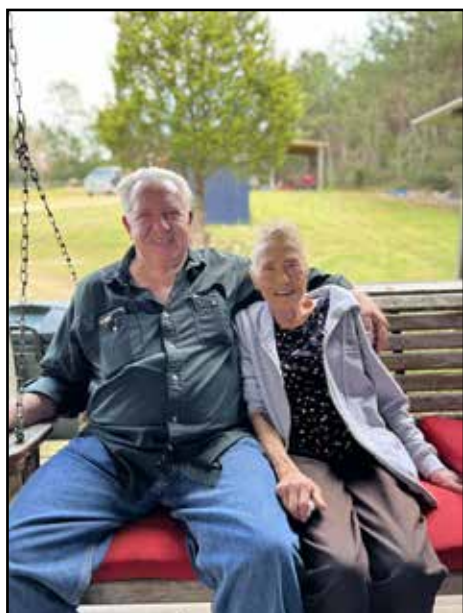
