

Claud "Bud" Stanley, Sr., 81, a lifelong resident of Nederland and Beaumont, died Friday, December 1, 2023. He was born on July 22, 1942, to Lavada Maxine Montgomery Stanley and Claud L. Stanley, in Overton. Bud was a 1960 graduate of Nederland High School and a 1964 graduate of Lamar University.

He owned Triangle Inventory from 1968 and bought Tex Cal

Inventory in 1989, merging the two companies until his retirement to the lake in 2009. Bud was a member of the Rotary Club of Beaumont, coached baseball, football, and the Special Olympics. He was an avid boxer in the Golden Gloves while holding several titles. Bud enjoyed running, writing poetry, fishing, and sailing.

The family would like to extend a special thank you to Danielle and Joyce for the excellent care and compassion they showed towards Bud.
















