Brenda Finch Tamplin, 81, known to many as Mimi and MawMaw, passed from this life on the morning of December 16, 2023, at Memorial Hermann Baptist Hospital in Houston, surrounded by her two children. She was born on March 18, 1942, to Ruth and Fabe Finch in Elton, Louisiana, where she attended school.

She met her husband, Arthur Ray Tamplin, while living in Nederland. They were married on March 21, 1967, and raised Ray's daughter, Connie, and had a son together, Mark. Brenda and Ray were married until his death in September 2013.

Her funny one-liners and quick-on-her-feet remarks always kept friends and family members on their toes and was oftentimes the main entertainment at an event.
