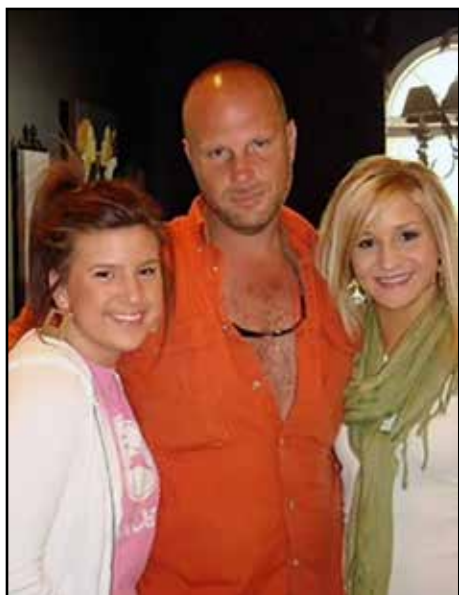

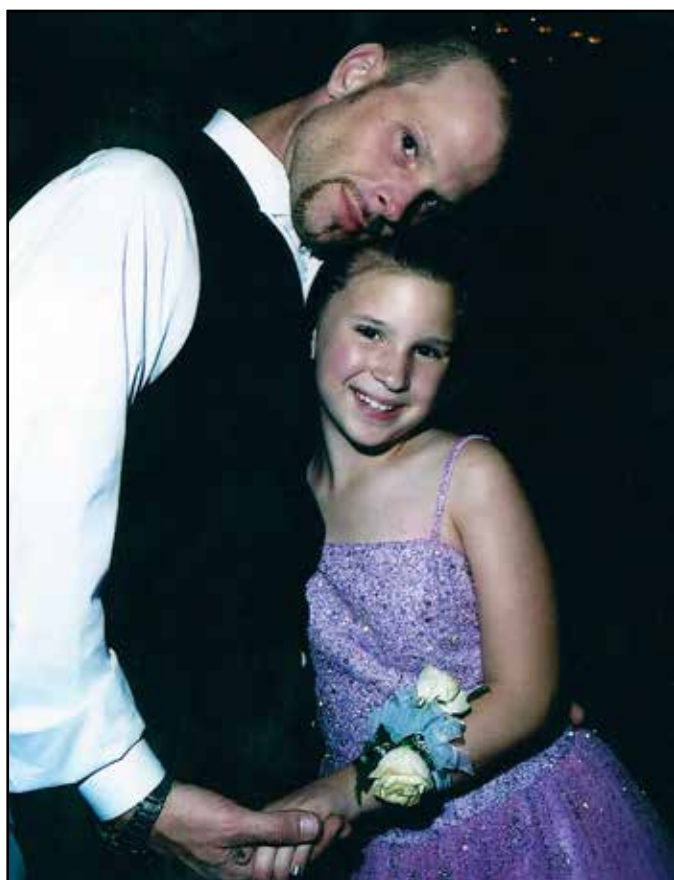

He is preceded in death by his parents, Freddie and Frank “Poncho” Barclay.

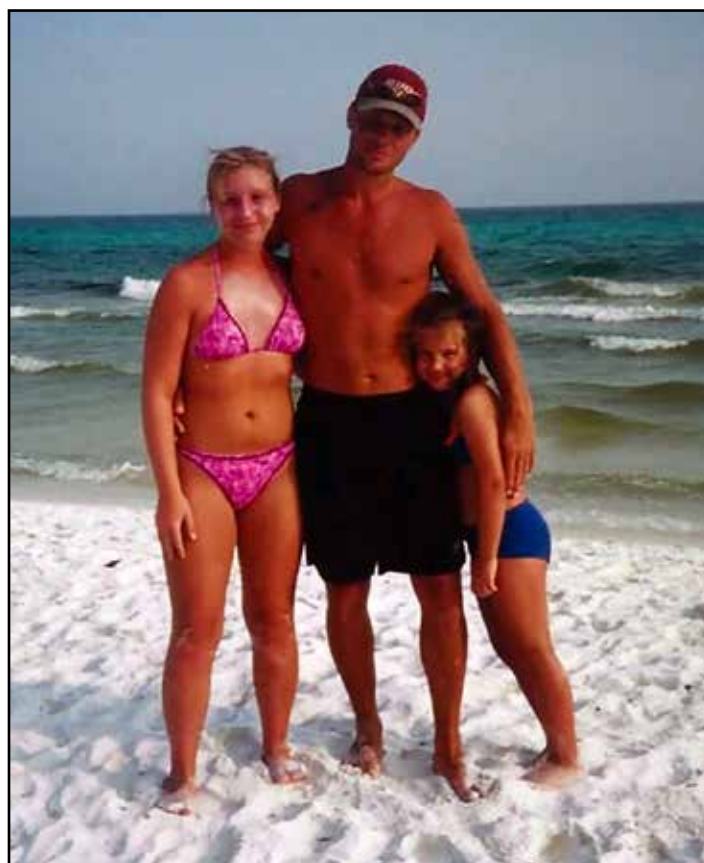
