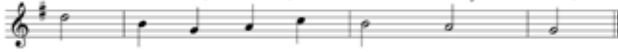

The family would like to acknowledge the loving caregivers and staff at Brookdale Dowlen Oaks. They went above and beyond in caring for Theresa.











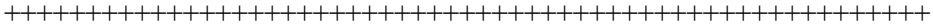




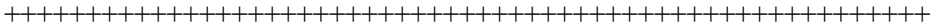
