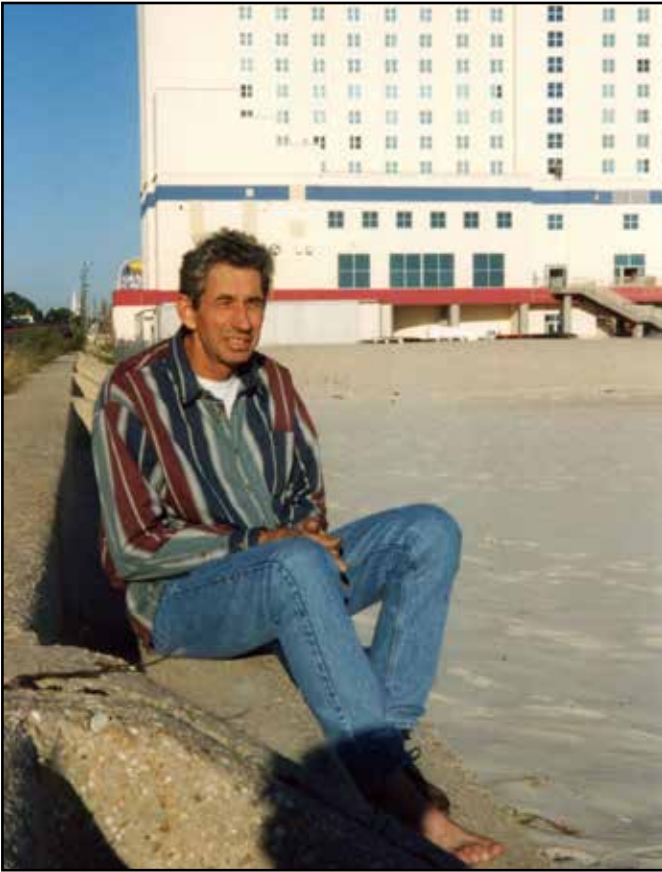

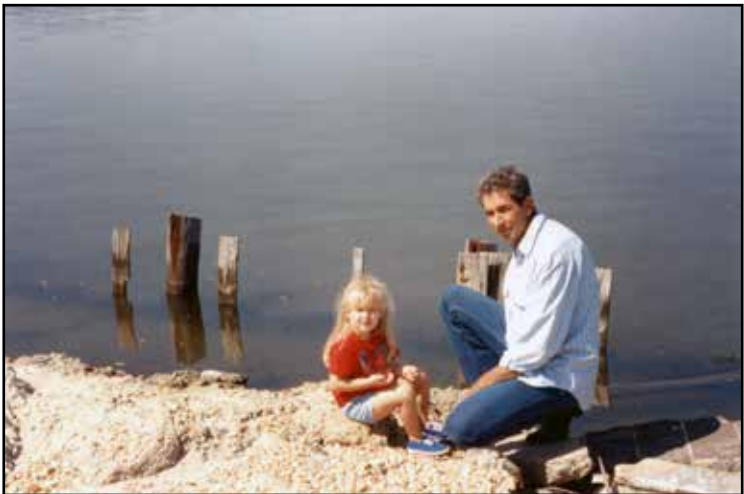
He is preceded in death by his mother and father.
