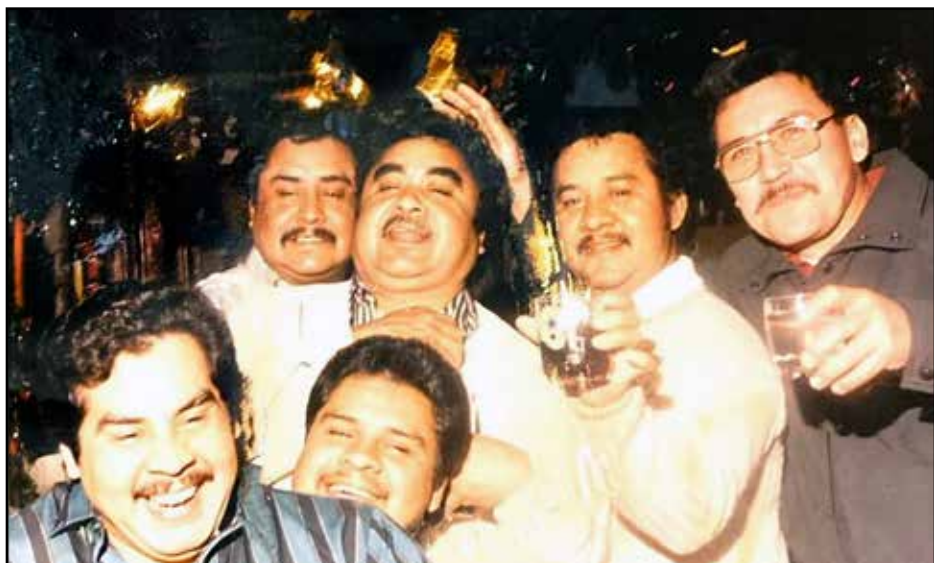

Beloved brother, uncle, friend, and father to numerous fur babies, PELON will be truly missed.

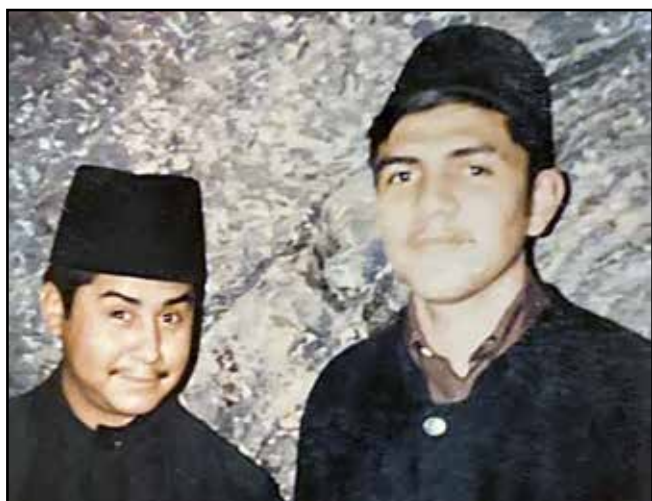
