Even though his time was cut tragically short here on earth, we know he's in the arms of Jesus and finally able to fish with his Paw Paw Ralph.

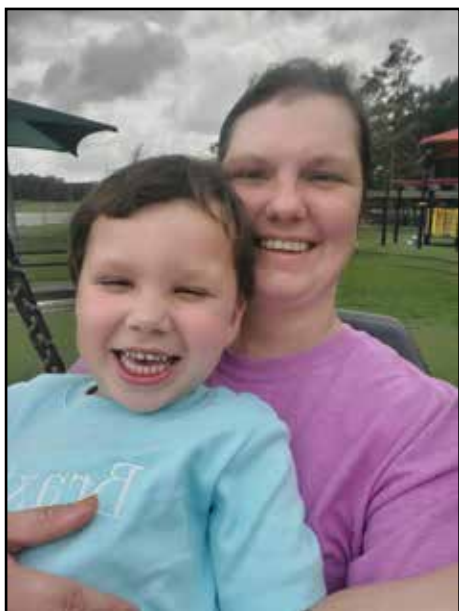
