Glenn is preceded in death by his parents, and wife, Wanda Mikko.



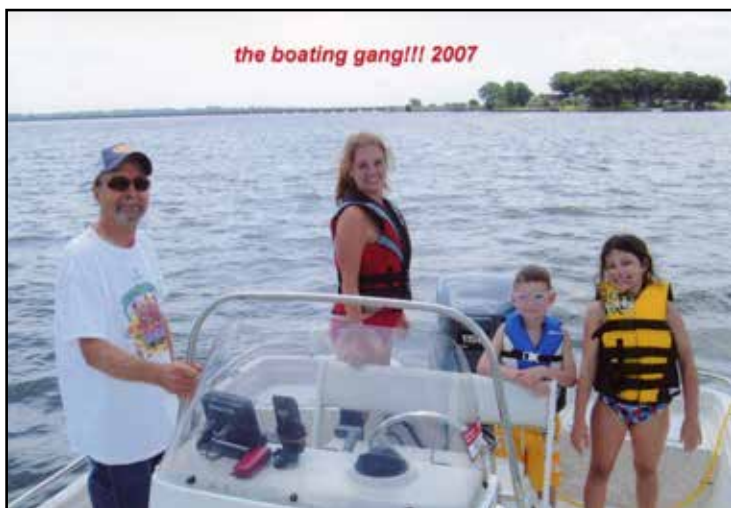







