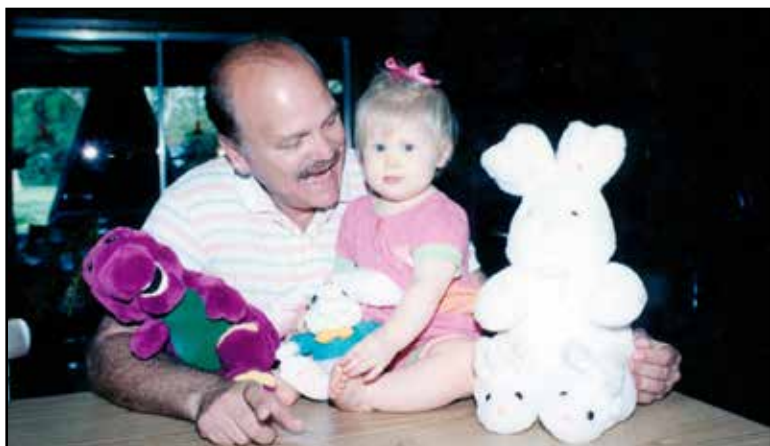

We pray that his soul may now be reunited with the Lord as well as with his wife, whom he so dearly missed and longed to see again.

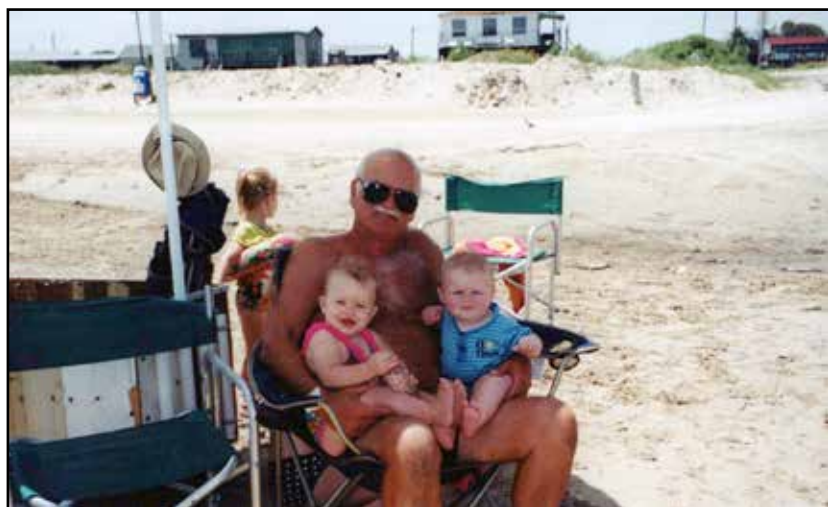




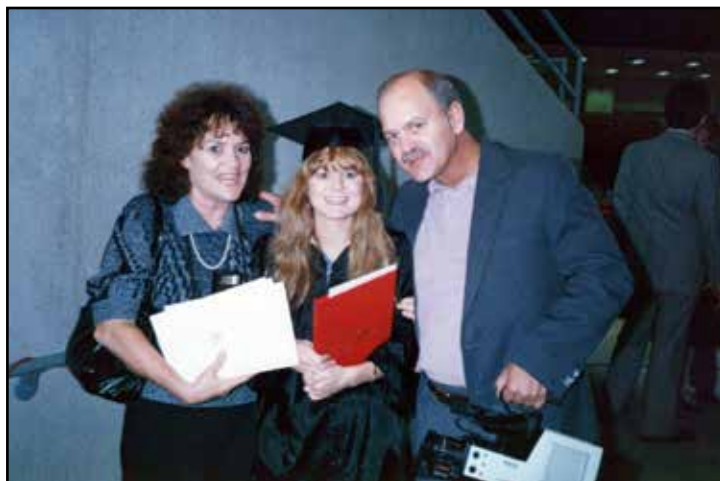
