Patsy Sue Parent Sedtal, 86, of Nederland, died Wednesday, April 17, 2024, at Houston Hospice surrounded by loved ones. She was born February 18, 1938, in Port Arthur, to Mona Marie Boudreaux Parent and Robert Pierre Parent.

She graduated from Thomas Jefferson High School in 1955 and received a degree from Port Arthur Business

College. She married Ronald Lee Sedtal on April 27, 1957, and were married for more than sixty years until Ronald's death on March 29, 2020. Patsy worked as a secretary until the birth of her first child, and then worked as a homemaker. She loved to sew and cook and prided herself in running the household. 
