She is preceded in death by her brother, Billy Dryden.

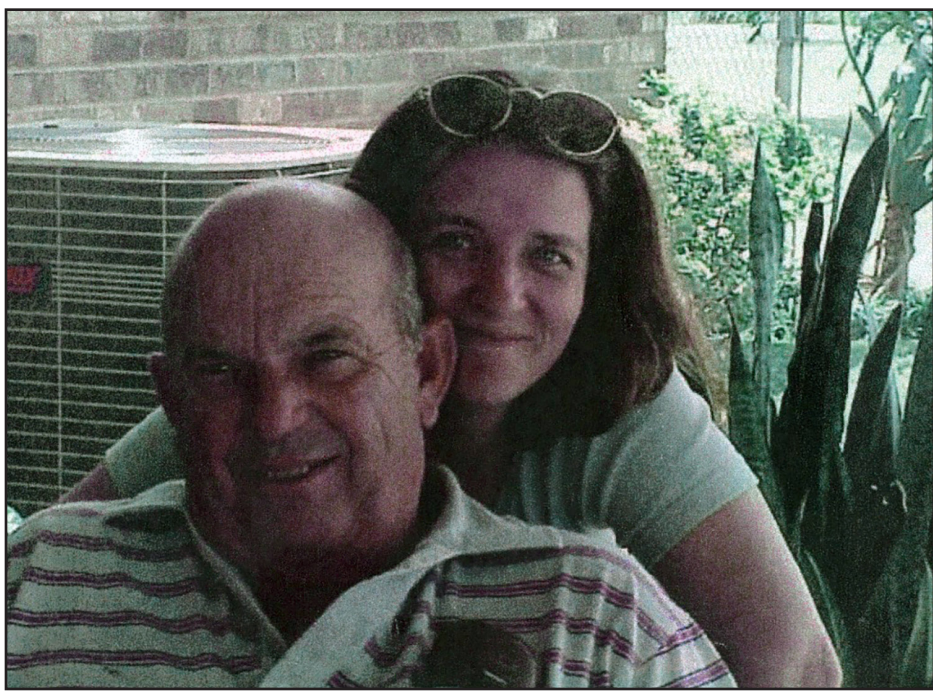










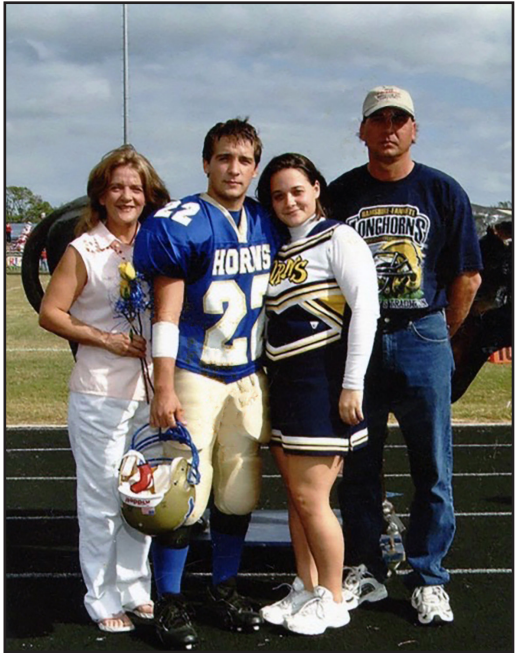
