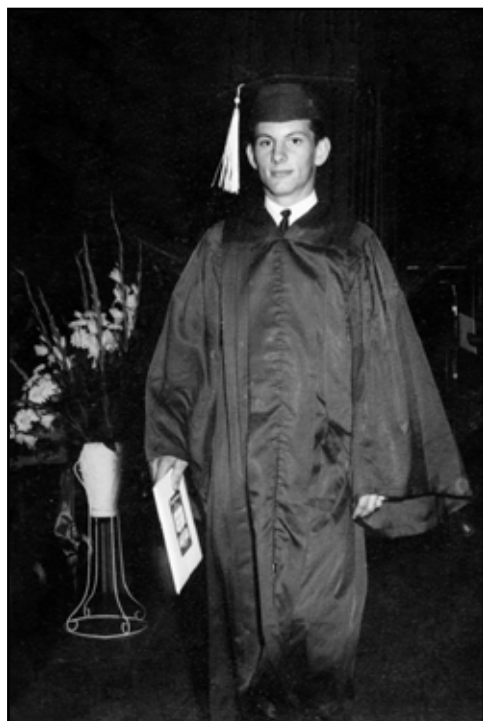

Woodrow is preceded in death by his parents, Woodrow and Virginia; wife, Connie Leone; and uncle, Clint Leone.








