

Orville Neil Odom, age 85, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, April 30, 2024, at Christus St. Elizabeth Hospital in Beaumont, Texas, surrounded by his loved ones. He was the youngest of five boys, born in Lufkin, Texas, on August 23, 1938, to James Thomas Odom and Clora Estelle Odom of Apple Springs, Texas.

Orville came from a small rural town in East Texas, filled with determination to obtain the best possible education, fulfilling a dream

Austin State College where he received his Bachelor of Science Degree.
