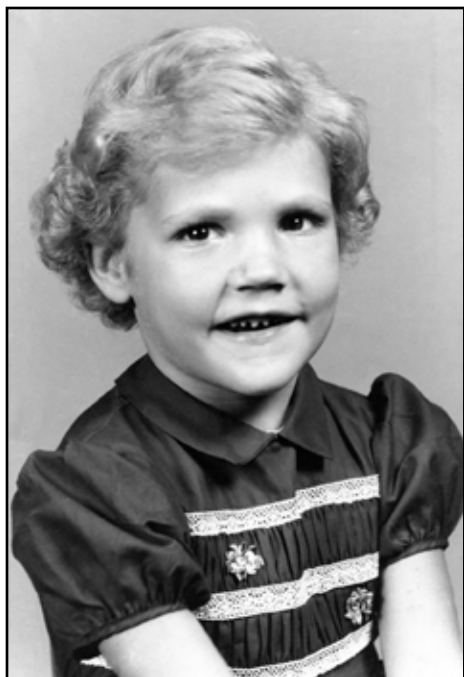
She loved holidays, planting flowers, and spending time with family.
