We invite you all to share pictures and memories. It was his wish that we laugh, reminisce and smile together during this time.



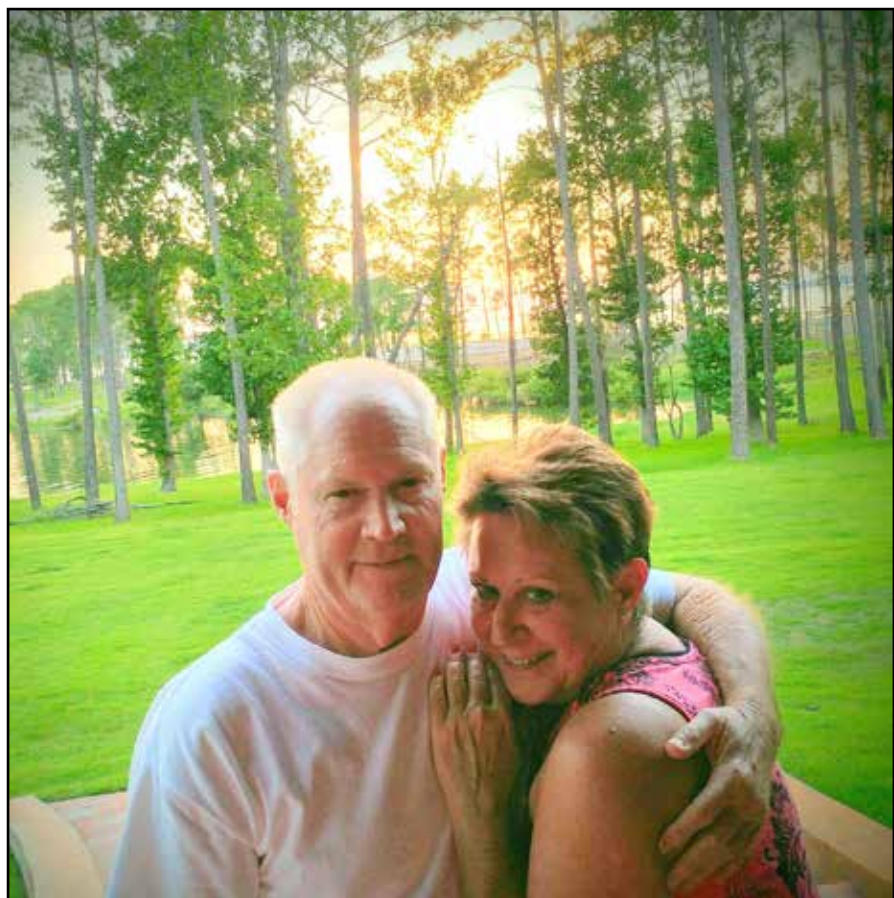
