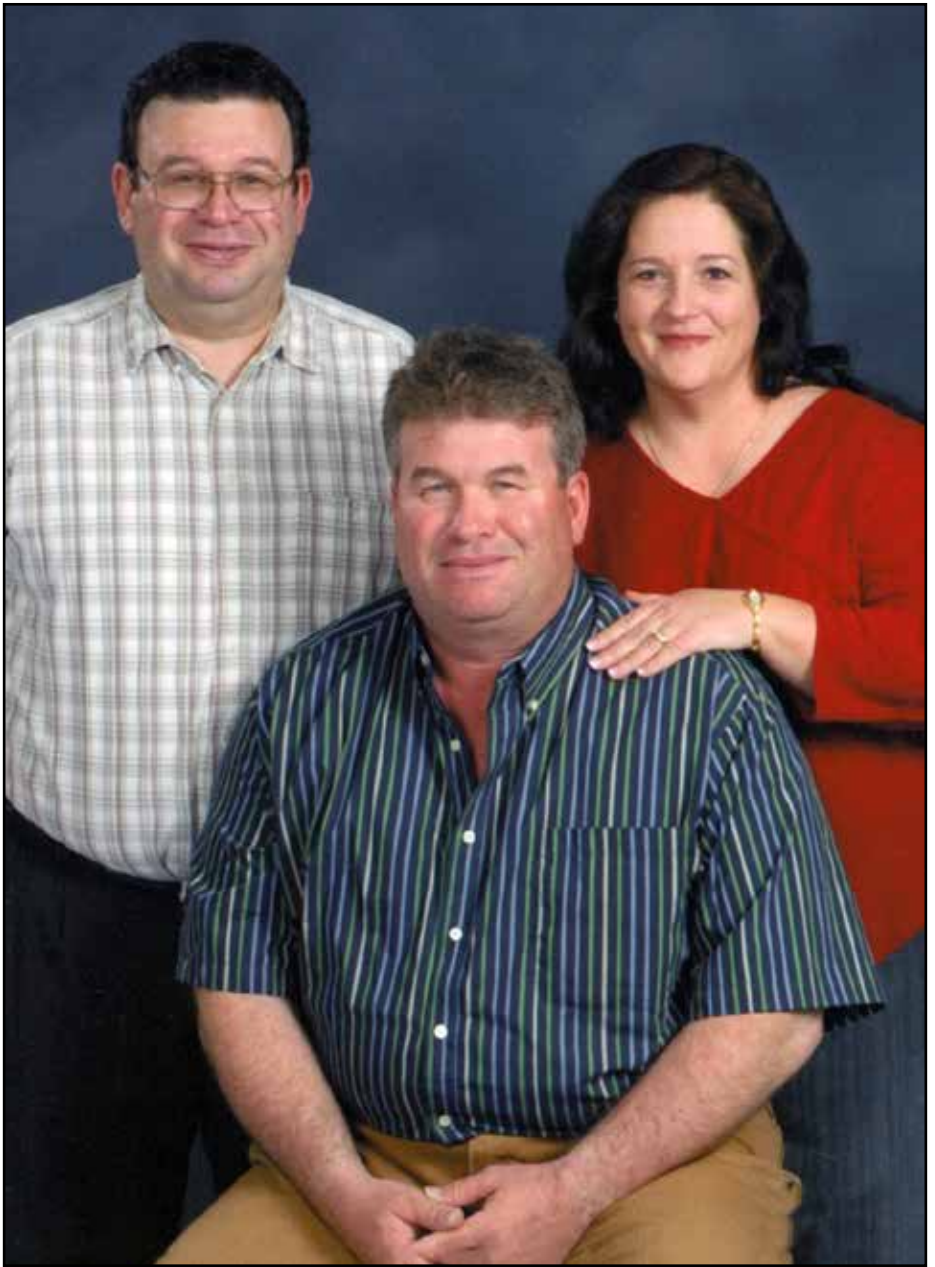
Chris is preceded in death by his parents, and brother, Peter Anthony Bonura.
