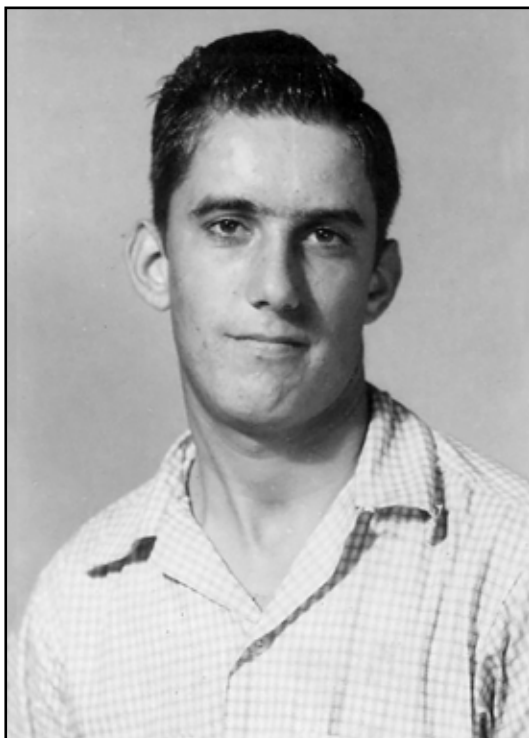

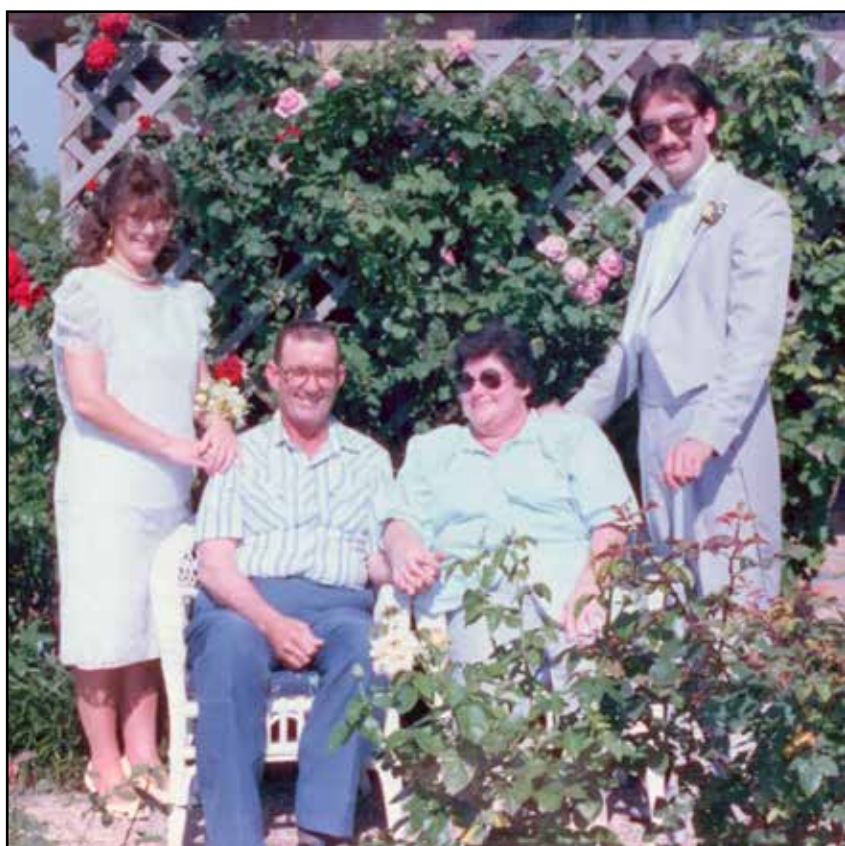
He is preceded in death by his parents; brother, Leonce Lege, Jr.; sister, Esther Broussard; and brother, Pierre Lege.

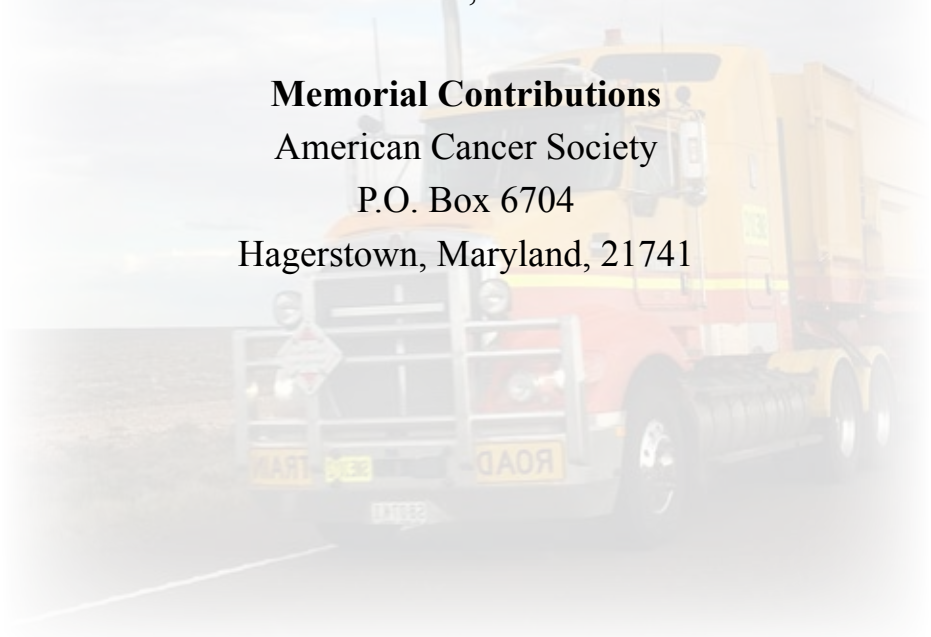
