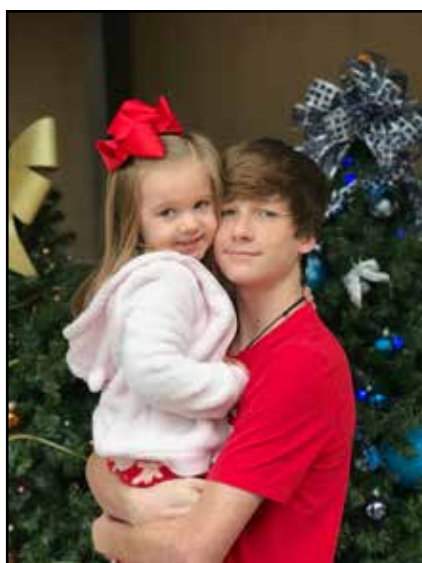

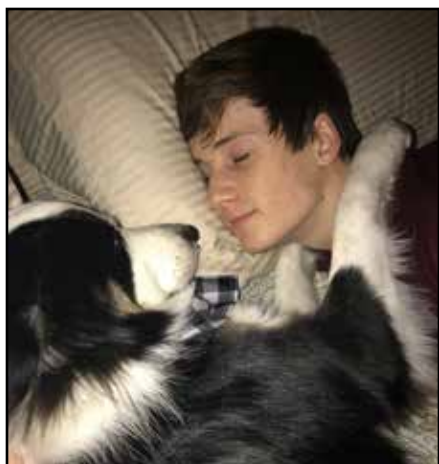
Mason is preceded in death by his grandfathers, Bob Szudzik, O.G. King, Jr., and Mark East; and Uncle, Jason Szudzik.
