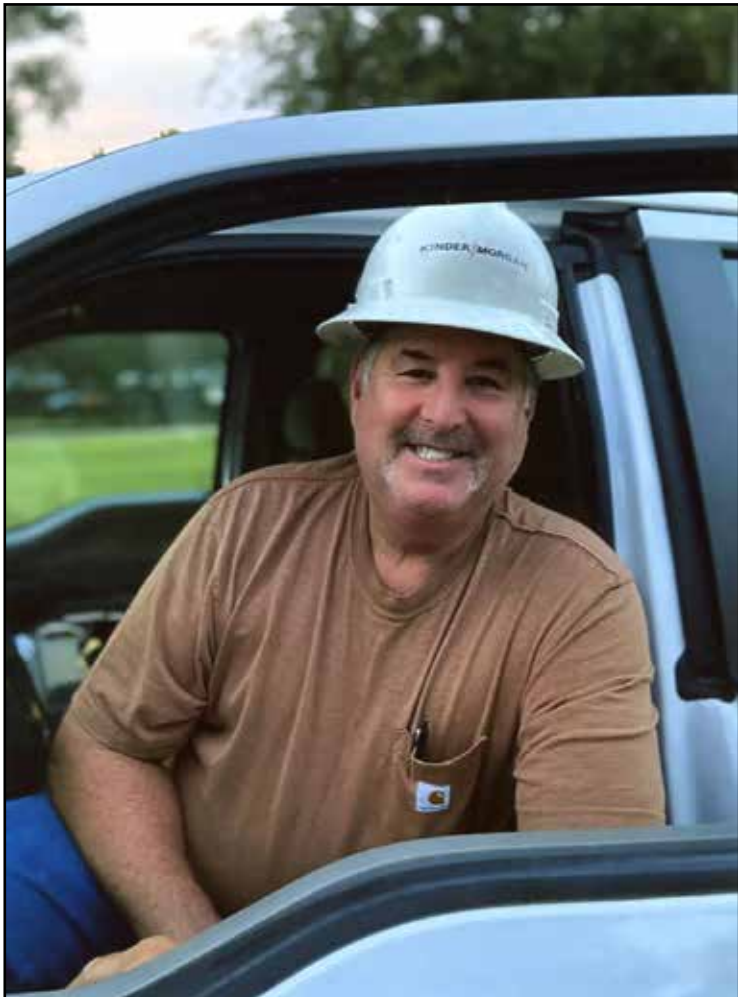
Year's Eve in 2006. Teddy and ReJena shared many adventures, from traveling with friends in the motorhome, hunting trips, and just being home together.

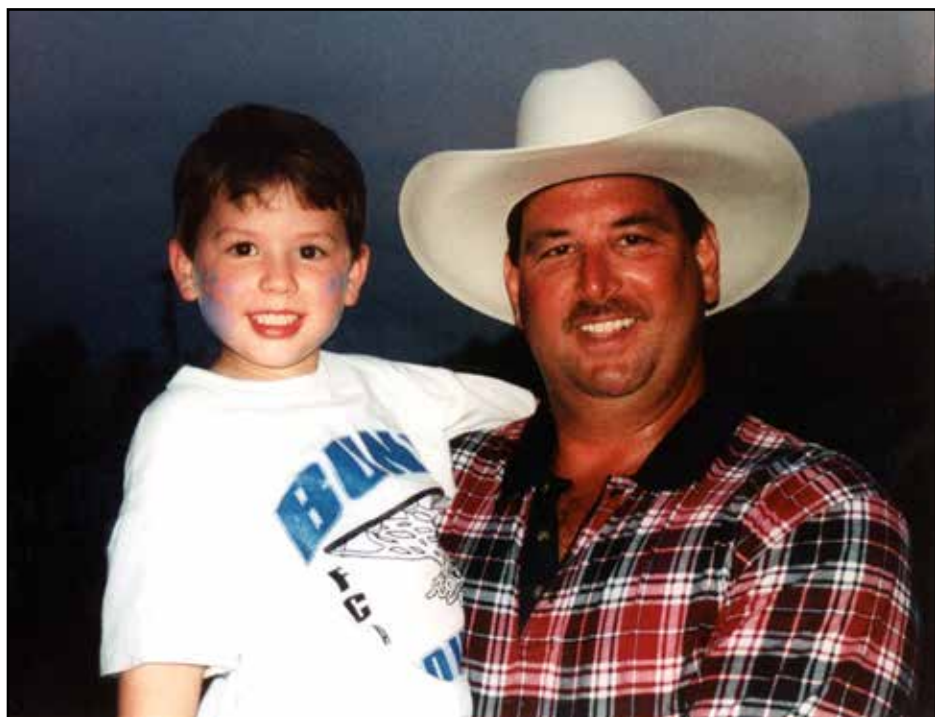

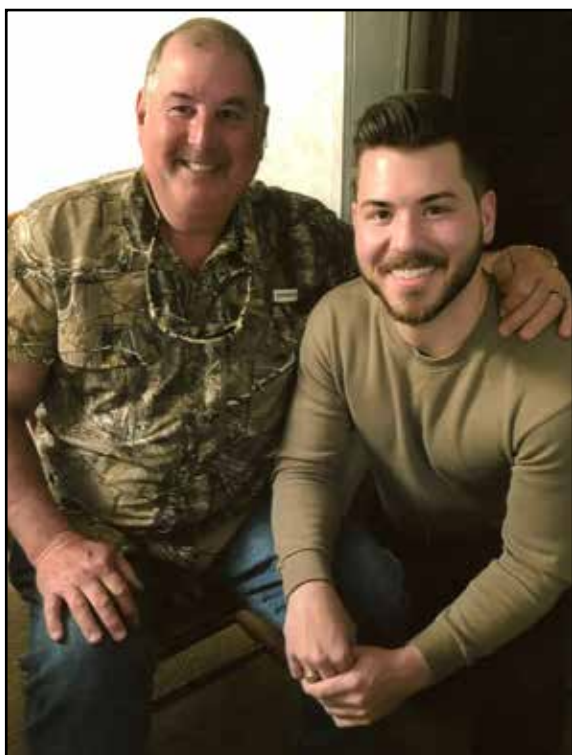






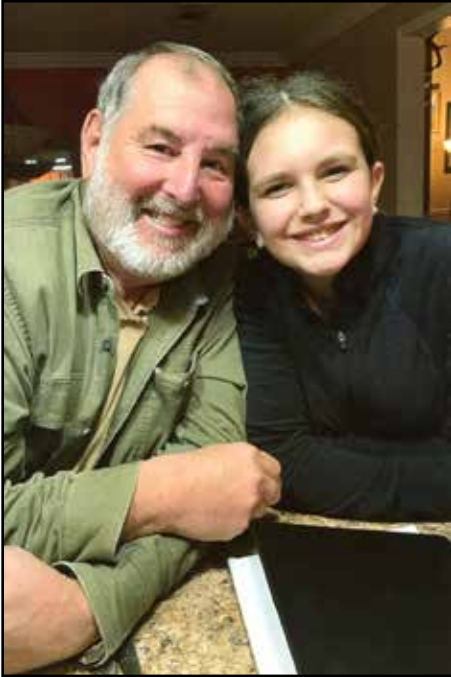
