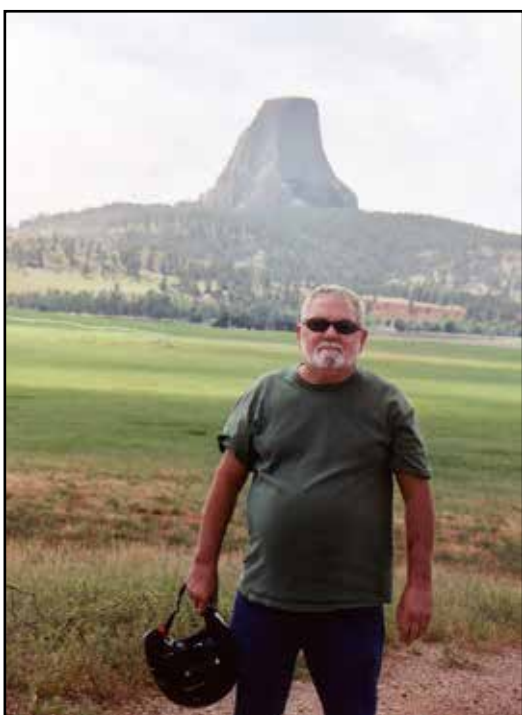
He is preceded in death by his parents; brother, Clifford Corbello, Jr.; and sister, Jaynell Weber.

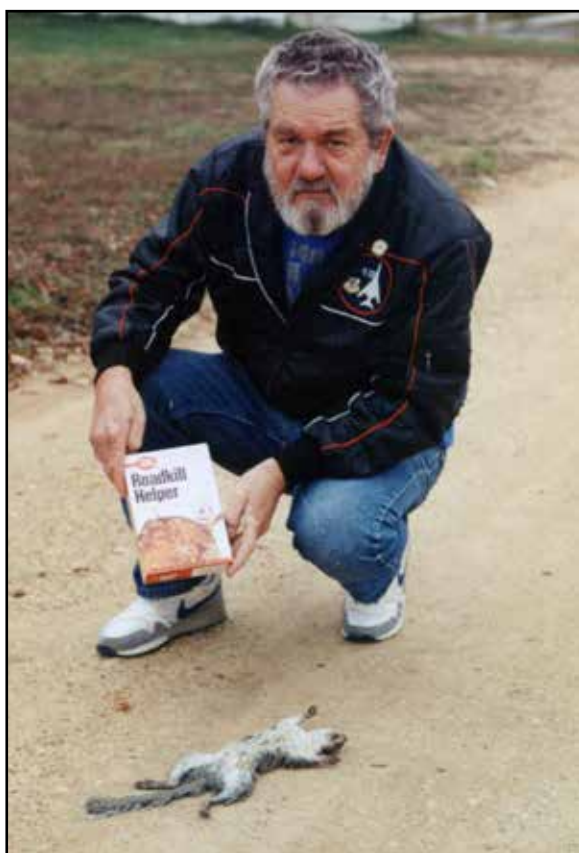
