Special Thanks to Josie Brucia, her sweet caring friend and neighbor who was always by her side until the very end.

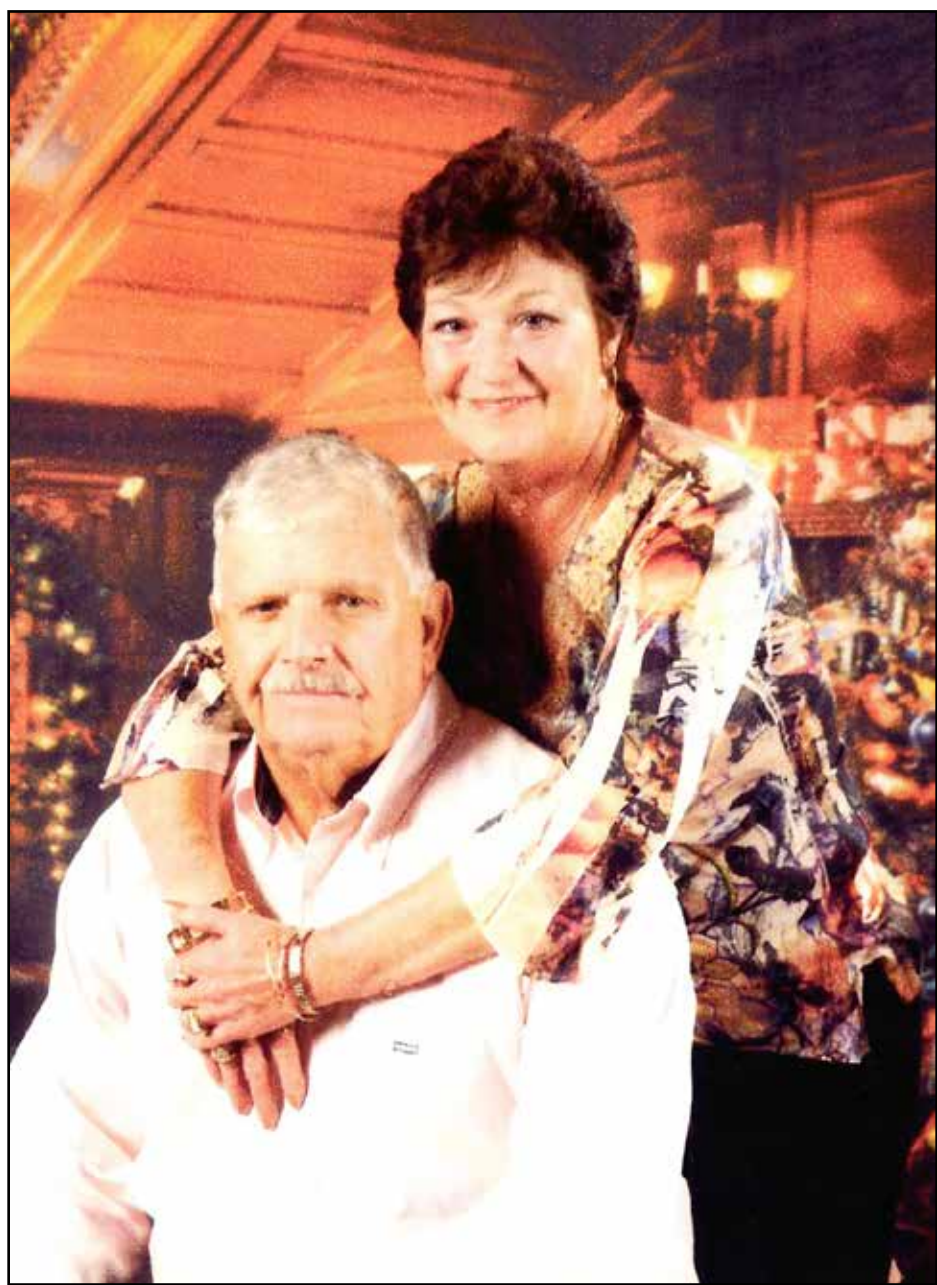


