April 9, 1938 - October 19, 2024



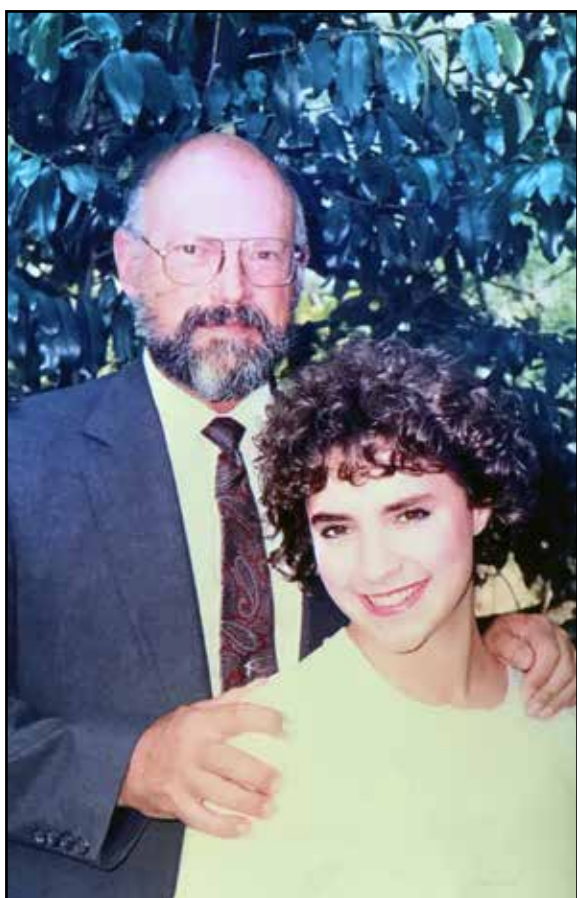

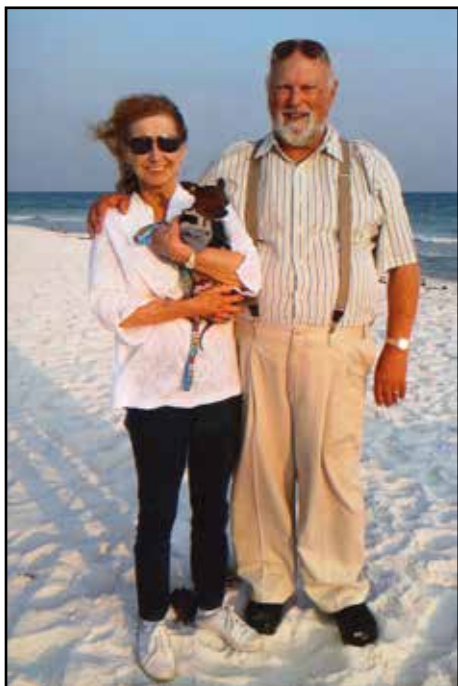
Dr. Spradley is preceded in death by his parents; wife, Lillie Spradley; and sister, Katy DiMayo.

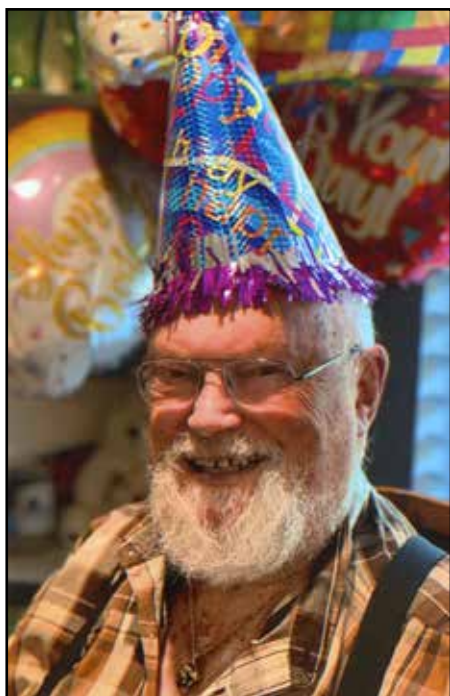




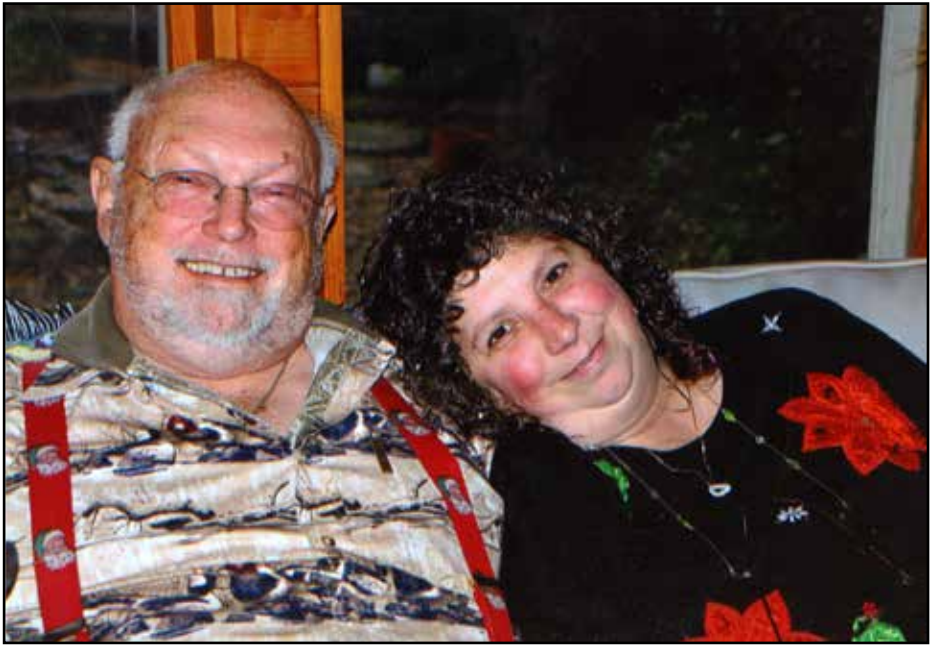
