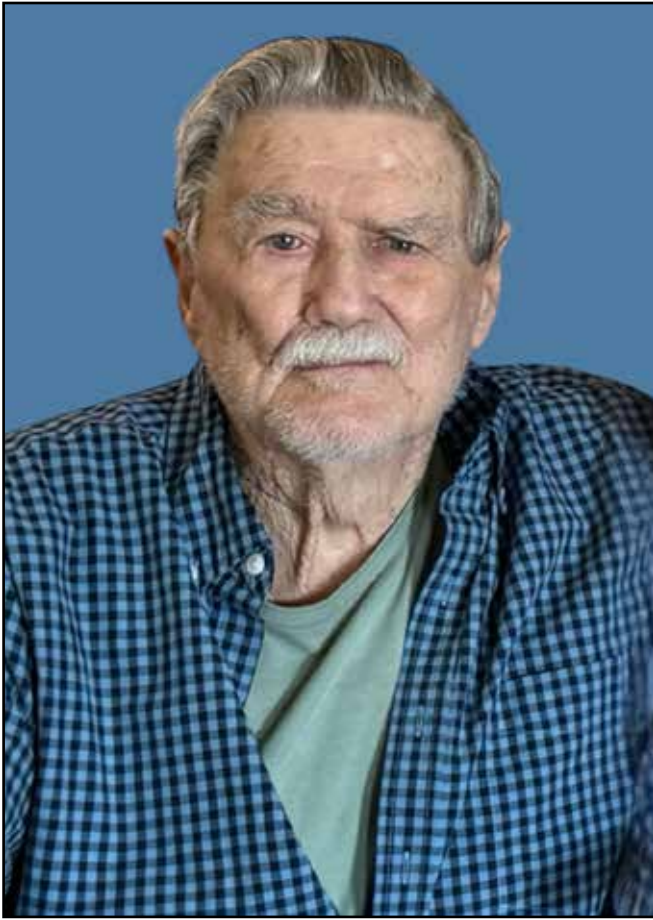
I've carried a burden

All I know is I need You (**Refrain**)

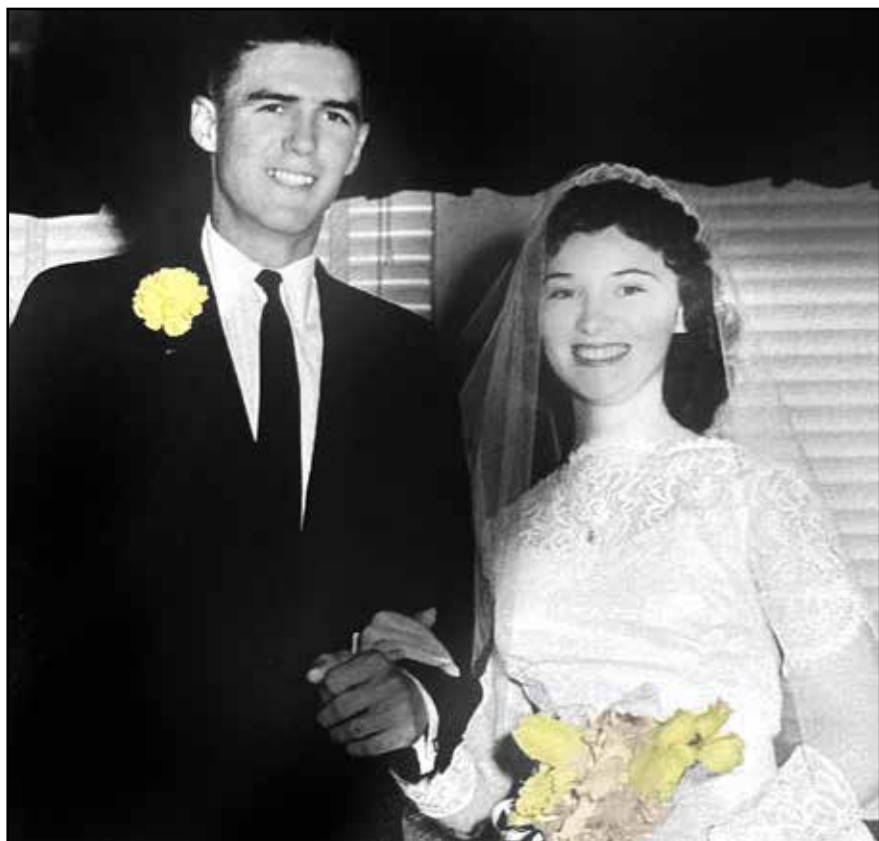
My heart has been in Your sights

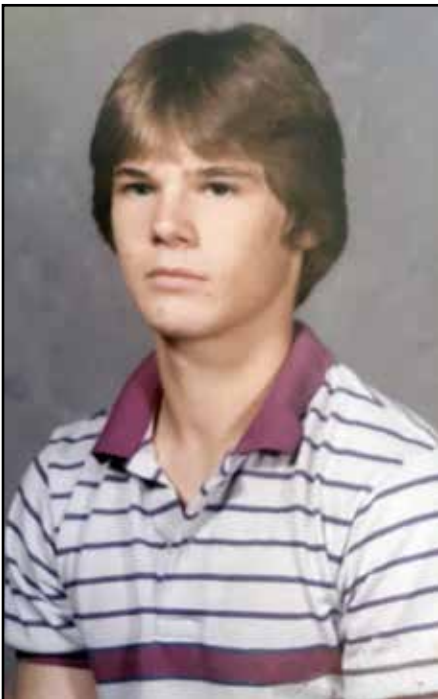
He was preceded in death by his mother, Odessa Stutz; father, Bennie Stutz; son, Clint McNeil; and grandson, Hunter Norton.
