July 9, 1942 - January 9, 2025



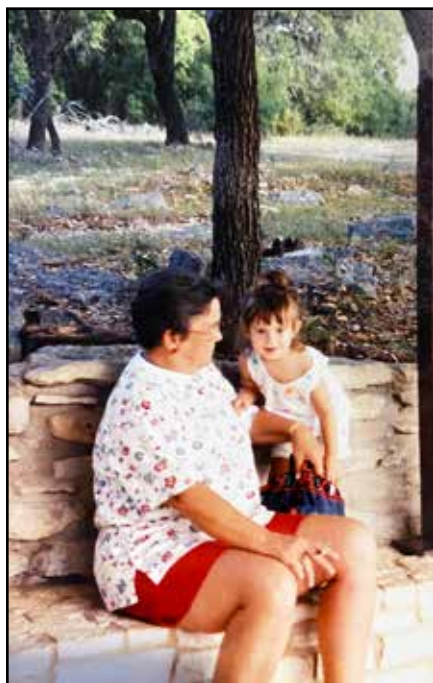
