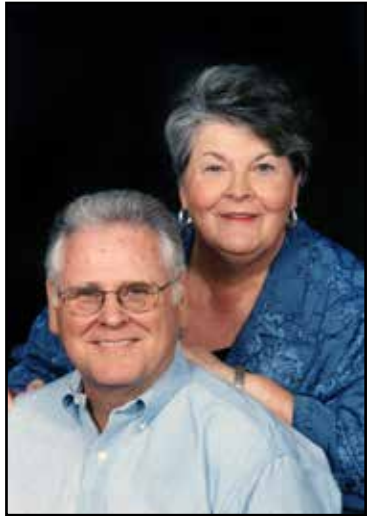
Carolyn is preceded in death by her precious son, Brent Taylor; parents, Clifton & Jewel Pedigo; and one sibling known as “brother.”
