R.C. Gunter, Jr., 97, of Nederland, Texas, passed away at his home on Sunday, April 20, 2025. He was born on September 8, 1927, to Ramsey and Pink Gunter.

He was one of six children. He attended school in Burkeville, Texas. He joined the U.S. Army in January of 1946. He was stationed at several military hospitals in the United States; Walter Reed General Army Hospital, Fitzsimmons General Army Hospital, and Brooke Army Medical Center.

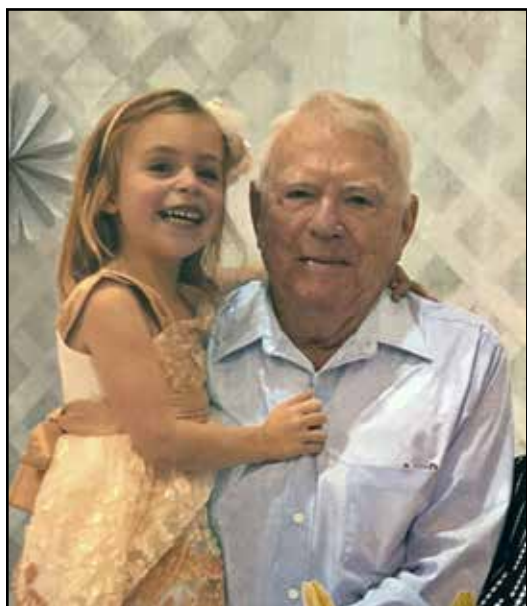

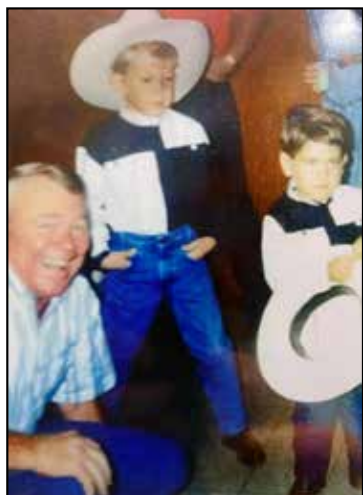

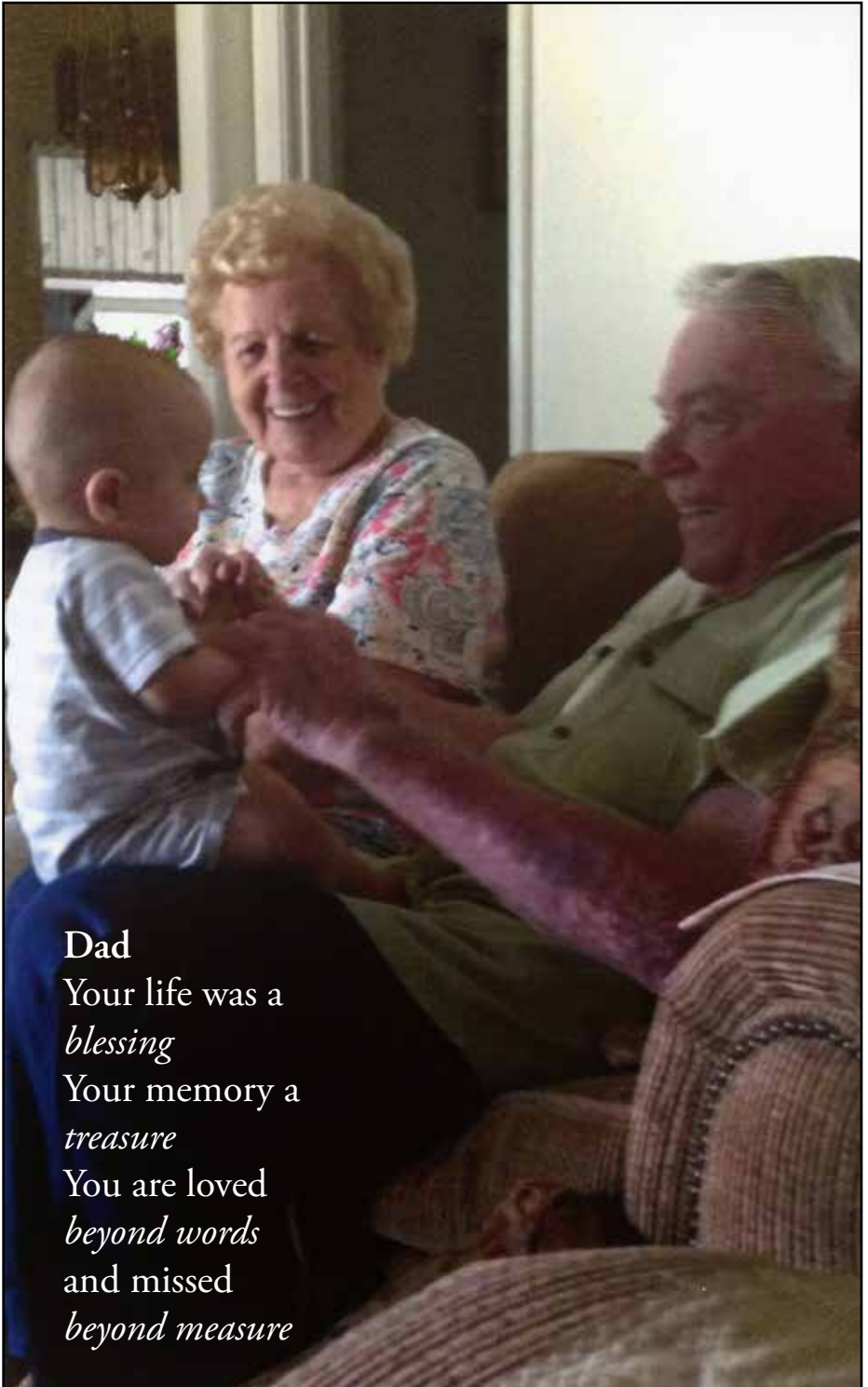
