He will be greatly missed by all.



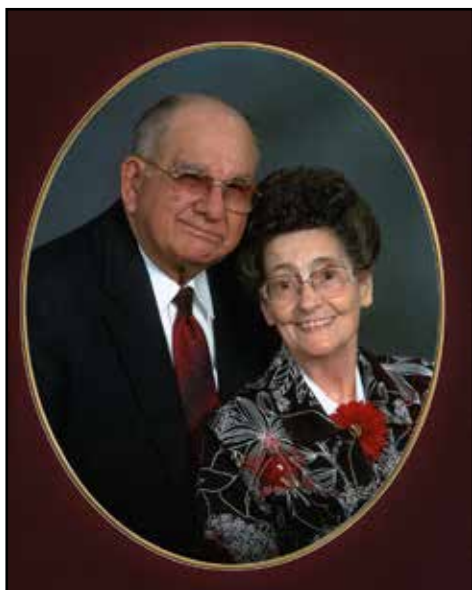
